

Fourth Sunday of Advent - 2016

The Fourth Sunday of Advent is the last Sunday before we celebrate the birth of our Savior, our Lord, Jesus Christ. What a blessing! What an honor! And what a privilege! As the readings of this Sunday prepare us for the upcoming Christmas, I have chosen to dwell on Mary's visitation to Elizabeth taken from the Gospel of Luke. In this visit, Elizabeth's greetings shared all the graces that God has endowed Mary and the Divine Power of the Child she carries in her womb. Here, Elizabeth says, 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy. Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

Let us reflect on what is going on with Elizabeth here. She knows Mary. She has heard about the visitation of God to her through the Angel Gabriel, and was so impressed at Mary's amazing faith and unqualified trust in God, which is called the "FIAT". Elizabeth was so joyful at Mary's humility, hence, God allowed her to experience the glimpse of God's grace, by letting John the Baptist in her womb leaped for joy. But, this is not the end of the story. The Divine grace empowered Elizabeth to discern that it was Jesus Christ in the womb of Mary that made the movement in her own womb to take place. Therefore, she sings with a great joy and an unimaginable feeling of gratitude, 'Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

My brothers and sisters, on this Fourth Sunday of Advent, the last Sunday before Christmas, we are invited to be joyful like Elizabeth in our lives because we are so blessed that the Savior is born for us. Emmanuel - God is with us.

<u>Friday, December 25: THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD - HAPPY CHRISTMAS</u>

Today, my dear brothers and sisters, a Savior is born for us and his name is Jesus, let us rejoice and be glad. Prophet Isaiah puts this joy in perspective in the first reading when he says, "How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings glad tidings, announcing peace, bearing good news, announcing salvation, and saying to Zion, "Your God is King!" Who else is the Prophet speaking about, but the baby Jesus, born for us today in Bethlehem, let us rejoice and be glad. Today, God has visited man so that humanity can be divinized and divine be humanized and Adam and Eve and their children have hope of reconciliation with God once again. My people, this indeed calls for gratitude to God.

It is this gratitude that John captures in his Gospel this

Christmas when he says, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be. What came to be through him was life, and this life was the light of the human race; the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." John helps us to understand that the love of God for us, is not an accident. It was love that has been with the Most Holy Trinity from the eternity. It is this love that God shared with our fore parents Adam and Eve, which they lost due to the sin of disobedience. But God still does not want the people He created in their image and likeness to be damned, so, he sent His only Begotten Son to be born of the Virgin Mary, (The Incarnation), been like us in everything but sin.
