Effective May 23, 2021, Pentecost Sunday, the temporary protocols for the celebration of the sacraments initiated during the COVID-19 pandemic will be rescinded and the temporary dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, which I granted because of the pandemic, will be lifted. I joyfully invite all Catholics back to in-person participation in the sacraments and the life of the parish.

<u>Year of Domestic Church—May 2021</u> <u>Celebrating Parents</u>

Parents are "Sponsors" of the Catholic Faith. Parents are the point of access between the Church and their children. To differing degrees, neighborhoods, and mainstream cultural attitudes toward religion have all declined as cultural "carriers" of Catholic belief.
