Anyone who is new to ministry in the Diocese of Austin must complete the EIM Application for Ministry (www.austindiocese.org/application) and attend an in-person EIM Workshop (www.austindiocese.org/initial-eim-training) within 60 days, and update/renew compliance at least once every three years. Online EIM Training is available (www.austindiocese.org/workshop#EIMOnline) for existing applicants who previously attended a workshop and are due to update/renew their compliance. **The online training will end on January 2, 2022.**
