And in the Eucharist, we participate in the wedding feast of the lamb; the eternal wedding banquet of heaven.

We see love outpoured and new life given. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* tells us "It is by following Christ, renouncing themselves, and taking up their crosses that spouses will be able to 'receive' the original meaning of marriage and live it with the help of Christ (1615)."

Online EIM Training is available (www.austindiocese.org/workshop#EIMOnline) for existing applicants who previously attended a workshop and are due to update/renew their compliance. The online training will end on January 2, 2022.
