

NEW EIM COMPLIANCE POLICIES FOR 2022:

EIM Policies require all clergy, religious, seminarians, employees and adult volunteers serving in any EIM compliance-required ministry to submit an EIM Application for Ministry (one-time only at www.austindiocese.org/ application) prior to service. New applicants must attend an in-person EIM Workshop within 60 days of application submission and all applicants must update/renew compliance at www.austindiocese.org/eim-compliance-status at least once every three years. NOTE: starting February1, 2022, new applicants must attend an in-person EIM Workshop within 30 days of application submission.


