#### ST ANN PARISH LIFE...come and be with us

<u>SEPTEMBER IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS.</u> The month of September is dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows, whose feast day is celebrated on September 15th. Our Lady suffered such anguish when she watched her Son's passion and death (Luke 2:35). Our Lord, while dying, gives John the Disciple (symbolically the Church) to His mother, so that we may have her aid. In the words of St. Therese of Lisieux, "She has given us so many proofs that she cares for us like a mother."



The Blessed Virgin Mary grants seven graces to the souls who honor her daily by meditating on her tears and dolors (sorrows). This devotion was passed on by St. Bridget.

#### Here are the Seven Graces:

1. I will grant peace to their families. 2. They will be enlightened about the divine mysteries. 3. I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work. 4. I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my divine Son or the sanctification of their souls. 5. I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives. 6. I will visibly help them at the moment of their death; they will see the face of their Mother. 7. I have obtained (this grace) from my divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolors, will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness since all their sins will be forgiven and my Son and I will be their eternal consolation and joy.

Unite Our Suffering With Our Lady of Sorrows. Here are the Seven Sorrows:

- 1. The First Sword of Sorrow: the prophecy of Simeon when he announces the suffering destiny of Jesus (Luke 2:34-35)
- 2. The Second Sword of Sorrow: the flight into Egypt—Mary escapes into Egypt with Jesus and Joseph (Matt 2:13-15)
- 3. The Third Sword of Sorrow: the loss of the child Jesus in the temple—Mary seeks Jesus lost in Jerusalem (Luke 2:41-51)
- 4. The Fourth Sword of Sorrow: the meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross—Mary meets Jesus as He carries His Cross to Calvary (cf. Luke 23:26-31)
- 5. The Fifth Sword of Sorrow: the Crucifixion and Death of Jesus—Mary stands near the Cross of her Son Jesus (John 19:25-27)
- 6. The Sixth Sword of Sorrow: the taking down of Jesus from the Cross—Mary receives into her arms the body of Jesus taken down from the Cross (cf. John 19:38)
- 7. The Seventh Sword of Sorrow: Mary helps place the body of Jesus in the tomb (cf. John 19:39-42)

**SAY** one **HAIL MARY** while meditating on each Sorrow..
