~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Is it true that “respectable” people never tremble over their salvation? Jesus speaks to those who consider themselves righteous, though in reality they are not. We can imagine his parable like a receptionist’s report: a Pharisee and a tax collector enter the temple to pray. Something significant happens.

The Pharisee compares himself to others and feels superior: “God, I thank you that I am not like other people...” God is not really needed; feeling better than others is enough.

The tax collector cannot lift his eyes. He knows his faults but turns humbly to God, hoping only for mercy. Human mercy cannot be relied upon. After praying, the tax collector goes home, changed, freed from hypocrisy, perhaps filled with kindness toward those he had wronged.

We all return to our ordinary lives. It is there, understood and saved by God, that we can take responsibility for our actions. Jesus’ verdict is clear: “This one went home justified, not the other.” One attained salvation; the other did not.

Even here in Las Vegas, people come and go, sometimes leaving changed for the better, sometimes for worse. God meets us in the ordinary, asking us to carry His mercy into the world.

There is no point in entering the church only to leave it unchanged.
