

### ~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~



This Sunday, we celebrate Christ the King. Unlike the kings we usually imagine – *powerful, commanding, and protected by soldiers* – Jesus' kingship is different, even a little strange.

He withdrew when people wanted to proclaim Him King, was abandoned when He spoke of giving His Body, and entered Jerusalem on a donkey with a crown of thorns, a reed as scepter, and a mocking mantle.

Pope Pius XI introduced this feast in 1925 to remind the world that true peace comes from Jesus, not power or violence, at a time when dictators like Hitler, Mussolini, and Stalin were rising. Jesus offers a peace rooted in self-sacrifice. He did not save Himself but gave Himself to save us and reconcile us to God.

Jesus challenges our understanding of leadership: the best leaders are humble and selfless; influence comes through mercy; authority is shown through service.

This applies to all of us. Life is made of choices – sometimes hard, sometimes small – that shape who we are. Choosing God and love leads to true happiness; choosing sin, anger, or selfishness shapes a different path. Look inward, not outward, to discern what is truly best for you. Let love guide your choices, not power.

Our world – even Las Vegas – could use more love, compassion, and understanding.

Our King was, is, and always will be a bit strange. And as His followers – that is, us – we might also seem a little strange to the world.
