~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Today we celebrate the temple – not just as a building, but as a source of life. In Scripture, the temple is called a source of living water (*Ezekiel, Psalms*), and *Saint Paul* reminds us it is made of living stones. Jesus Himself foretells His resurrection, transferring the temple from stones to His Body.

As Paul Badde writes in *The Heavenly City*, in the Apocalypse of Saint John there is a key to the mysteries of the world:

"And I saw the holy city, a new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband."

For nearly two thousand years, these words have shaped the lives of people and nations. On November 9, they are read in churches around the world, remembering the dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome in 324, built by Emperor Constantine shortly after Christians had endured persecution.

Here in Las Vegas, a city of lights and neon, we see a similar paradox: human achievements and spectacle alongside spiritual emptiness and the search for meaning.

We are called to find the *Key to the Temple* – Jesus Christ, the true Temple and source of life.

And this is why we gather today – at St. Joan of Arc, in the heart of the city – to encounter Christ present among us, and allow Him to transform our hearts.

The temple is not far away – it is here, it is in Him, and it is in you. Fr. Serge
