~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Joan of Arc,

This is the third time that the Lord comes to the disciples. The first time, on the day of the resurrection, when He gives them the Holy Spirit for the remission of sins. The second time, on the eighth day, when He comes for the faith of Thomas. The third time, when the disciples return to the beginning of their mission, to Galilee. They are back at the Lake of Tiberias.

They return to what they know well, fishing. Once again, at the word of Jesus, whom they had not yet recognized, they cast out their nets – after having experienced an unsuccessful catch. Once again, they learn to be together. There are seven disciples, certainly including the five apostles.

In today's Gospel, the role of Simon Peter is highlighted. He is the one who throws himself into the waves of the lake to appear before the Lord, to share a meal with Him, to be tested by Jesus.

As Jesus came for the faith of Thomas, so he comes for the love of Peter. A repentant Peter, a true Peter, a fragile and weak Peter, but a Peter who trusts Jesus completely: "Lord, you know everything, you know that I love you."

Jesus comes for our faith, he comes for my love and yours, he comes for confession. We hear the testimony of Peter, who had already experienced a miraculous catch and was then called to discipleship. Now Peter is tested in love and called to be the shepherd of the Church – "Feed my sheep, feed my lambs."

All this takes place at the word of Jesus.

The foundation of relationships is conversation.

But most of the time, we talk about people, not with people.

It is the same with God. We often talk about Him, but do we talk to Him?

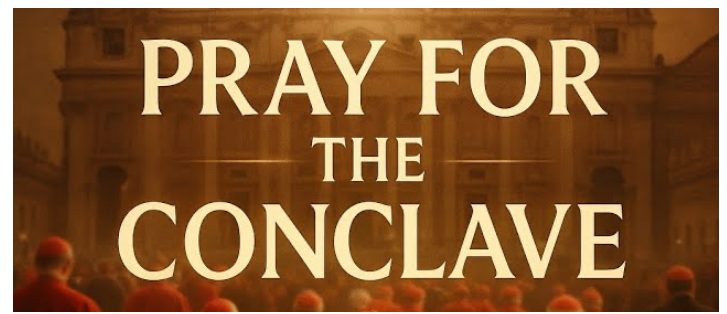
