~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

We all have experience eating meals. Yet, there is something more important that earthly food itself cannot provide: we don't like eating alone. I eat quickly, because there's no point in sitting at the table by myself. What I like most is eating together, when we can serve each other, take care of each other, and talk. Then, something amazing happens. I realize that what I cannot take for myself is something I can receive and give to another person. Love emerges. Jesus became food for us in the Eucharist. Through it, he teaches us fellowship – being together. He offers us the food of forgiveness at the beginning of Mass. He teaches us to savor the food we receive, to celebrate it, and to be grateful. He teaches us to serve one another, and finally he sends us to our brothers and sisters to care for them more than ourselves. This is what we call Eucharistic spirituality. It is the spirituality of being fed and loved, of feeding and loving our brothers and sisters. This is the meaning of today's Feast...

A man prayed eagerly to God, asking to see heaven and hell. So, God took the man to a large hall with a pot of delicious food in the middle. People sat around it with long spoons, scooping food from the pot. They looked terribly miserable, though: they were thin, pale, and sad. The atmosphere was gloomy and cold. The spoons had such long handles that it was impossible to bring the wonderful food to their mouths. When they brought the spoons closer, the last drops of soup fell from them. Everyone was hungry, even though the pot of soup was right in front of them. It was hell.

Then, God led the man to a second room that looked like the first. In the center of this room was a pot of food, and around it were people with long spoons. These people, however, were well-fed, healthy, joyful, and happy. None of them tried to feed themselves. Each person was being fed by the person sitting opposite them, and, at the same time, feeding that person with their own spoon. This place was heaven. Let us pray to love one another.
