#### ~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Today's Gospel is a powerful call to action. It is a summons, a mission, a promise. It reveals our destiny, purpose. It reminds us that being Catholic is not something we hide; it's something we bring to the world with courage and joy. Our deepest joy is not in what we do for God, but in what God has done for us. He has written our names in heaven and claimed us as His own. And from this identity flows our mission. We don't go into the world to prove something; we go to share Someone. We don't carry opinions; we carry Christ.

So, what should we take from this Gospel today?

- **1. Go! Don't Wait**. Jesus said, "Go on your way." Don't wait for the world to come to you. Don't wait to feel perfect. Don't wait for the culture to become comfortable. Go into conversations, acts of kindness, and public witness. Go into the world humbly Christian and joyfully apostolic.
- **2. Be Courageous**. You may be "lambs among wolves." But never forget: the Lamb of God has already conquered the wolves. The Cross was not the end; it was the victory. You carry that victory within you. Don't be afraid.
- **3. Live Simply and Faithfully**. "Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals." In other words, don't be weighed down. You don't need to have all the answers. You don't need a perfect life. What you need is faith, a willing heart, a spirit of peace. Bring peace to the homes you enter, even if it's only through a kind word or a quiet prayer.
- **4. Rejoice**. Not because the world approves; not because you're always right. Rejoice because your name is written in heaven, because you belong to Christ. Rejoice because even when the mission is hard, He is with you always.

So go, brothers and sisters. Be Catholic in the coffee shop, on social media, at your kids' football game. Be Catholic when it's hard, when it costs you something. You're made for this mission. Christ walks with you. Amen. Fr. Serge

#### **IUBILEE PILGRIMAGE SITE**

The Jubilee Year began on December 24, 2024, when Pope Francis opened the Holy Doors at St. Peter's Basilica. The doors will remain open until the end of the Jubilee Year on January 6, 2026. During this time, millions of pilgrims are expected to travel to Rome to walk through the Holy Doors. Those who can't travel

to Rome can participate in the Jubilee locally by making a pilgrimage to Guardian Angel Cathedral, the special pilgrimage site for our Archdiocese.
