~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

In today's Gospel, a man asks Jesus to settle a dispute over inheritance. But Jesus doesn't act as a mediator – instead, He addresses the real issue: greed. He warns, "Guard against all greed, for life does not consist in possessions."

Jesus doesn't condemn wealth or planning wisely. What He challenges is the illusion that security or happiness can be found in having more.

The parable that follows speaks of a rich man who tears down his barns to build bigger ones, thinking his future is secure. But that very night, his life is taken. He stored up treasure for himself but was not rich in what matters to God.

This Gospel calls us to reflect: What are we building our lives on? Are we measuring success by what we accumulate, or by how we love, serve, and give?

Greed is not just about money – it can be our need to control, to be right, to be admired. It begins when we seek fulfillment in things, rather than in God.

The remedy? Gratitude.

A grateful heart loosens its grip, shares freely, and sees all as gift.

Let us ask the Lord this week for the grace to be rich not in things, but in faith, in generosity, and in love. May our lives reflect the treasure that truly lasts.

A JUBILEE YEAR is a special time in the Church's tradition, observed every 25 years, to encourage holiness through acts of reconciliation and communion with others. Holy Father has announced that 2025 will be a Jubilee Year, themed "Pilgrims of Hope".

JUBILEE PILGRIMAGE SITE

The Jubilee Year began on December 24, 2024, when Pope Francis opened the Holy Doors at St. Peter's Basilica. The doors will remain open until the end of the Jubilee Year on January 6, 2026. During this time, millions of pilgrims are expected to travel to Rome to walk through the Holy Doors.

Jubilee locally by making a pilgrimage to Guardian Angel Cathedral, the special pilgrimage site for our Archdiocese of Las Vegas.


