~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that each of us is a steward. Life itself is a gift from God, and with it come responsibilities.

The first lesson is to have a clear goal: if we don't know where we are going, we risk wasting our lives, just as the steward in the Gospel squandered his master's property, or the prodigal son wasted his inheritance. We are called to keep our eyes on the ultimate goal – eternal life – and not get lost in comfort, success, or efficiency alone.

The second lesson is that true wealth is not money or possessions, but people. Even in the largest companies today, the most valuable resources are trust, reputation, and relationships. The steward was praised by his master because he began to care for others. Forgiving debts in the parable is also a picture of mercy: when we forgive, we reveal the heart of God, merciful, compassionate, forgiving.

Finally, Jesus teaches us about fidelity. "You cannot serve both God and Mammon." Every choice, even in the smallest matters, shapes our soul. Faithfulness keeps us on the path toward the eternal goal. Today, let us ask the Lord for three gifts: prudence, so that we do not waste our lives; mercy, so that we may forgive as God forgives; and fidelity, so that we may persevere on the road to His Kingdom.
