



~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Do you think the rich man knew Lazarus' name?
He passed him daily, yet never saw him, never asked his name.

Lazarus had a name. The rich man did not.

Like the people of Zion in today's First Reading, we can become comfortable, distracted, or indifferent to the suffering around us.

St. Paul reminds us: "*Fight the good fight, O man of God.*" Following justice, faith, love, patience, and gentleness is a daily effort – a choice to rise above the comfort that blinds us to the needs of others.

Lazarus may be lying in our streets, in our cities, in places we don't notice. Sometimes we feel powerless, sometimes we just don't want to see. But even a small gesture – acknowledging a person, learning their name, listening to their story – can awaken our hearts to God's presence in them.

"*Truth is the bond that links words to things, names to faces,*" said Pope Leo XIV. Real life demands that we step out toward others, forming sincere and lasting relationships. Without them, there is no mature, full life.

Get to know Lazarus.

Wake up your heart.

Love him – and in him, you will find God...
