~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Jesus' public ministry begins with His baptism in the Jordan; an event still shrouded in mystery. Why would the sinless One enter a baptism meant for sinners? John's baptism was a call to repentance and preparation, not the sacrament we know today. Jesus did not need conversion; He entered the waters for us, choosing to stand in solidarity with humanity and to unite Himself with our lives.

The setting itself speaks volumes. The Jordan Valley lies below sea level, the lowest place on earth. It is there, in that place of descent, that God chooses to be revealed. Jesus is not afraid of the depths of human life: our sin, shame, failures, and distance from God. He enters those depths with us, but He doesn't remain there. Rising from the water, He lifts us up, and the Father's voice is heard: "*You are my beloved Son*" – words spoken over every baptized daughter and son.

Many of us know that God loves us, yet those words can remain distant. Today's feast reminds us of something even more personal: God not only loves us, but He delights in us.

At the Jordan, God meets us where we are and calls us beloved, not because we are perfect, but because we are His. In baptism, we are claimed, raised up, and sent forth as sons and daughters who are loved, and liked, by God.
