~ FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ~

Jesus tells us today, "You are the light of the world... You are the salt of the earth." Short words, simple words, yet full of challenge.

Las Vegas dazzles with lights, casinos, and neon competing with the desert stars, but all that brilliance is meaningless without people who live with hearts open to love, mercy, and kindness.

Jesus calls us to be authentic light: touching darkness, warming hearts, and guiding others when life feels uncertain.

Salt transforms, preserves, and heals. Today we think of it as seasoning or a way to melt ice, but salt's story is deeper. In Scripture, it is sacred – used in covenants, for life-giving water, and as a sign of trust.

Jesus does not say "you may be salt," but clearly, "you are the salt of the earth."

Yet salt can lose its taste. Contaminated, it is no longer salt, and according to the Talmud (an ancient Jewish collection of teachings and laws) it is scattered underfoot to prevent harm.

In the Gospel, "losing its taste" in Greek is *mōranthē*, literally "to become foolish."

Allegorically, it's a warning: Christians who drift from Christ, distracted by other attachments, lose their flavor. They stop being light. They stop being salt. They become, in a sense, foolish – not helping the world, not making a difference. They can only be trampled...

It stings, doesn't it? Like salt in the eye. FR. SERGE
