## *Giving the Gift of Education Helps Salvadoran Students Achieve Their Dreams*



Our parish is committed to supporting 20 high school and 12 university students each year in our sister community San Rafael Cedros, El Salvador.

Please consider if you, your family, a ministry or other group in which you are active can commit to providing the education of one student.

The cost of sending a student to high school for one year is \$300 and students attend 2-3 years, depending on their goals.

One year of University is \$1,050 and students attend 4-6 years.

A special collection to support these scholarships will be next weekend, **September 15-16 at all Masses.**

In the story we hear from Mark's Gospel this week, Jesus continues to be on the move as he makes his way into the district of the Decapolis. This location is significant because Jesus is moving out of Jewish territory into Gentile territory. This signals that Jesus' ministry is being extended to Gentiles as well as Jews. All are in need of God's healing so Jesus shows this in a very real way as he cures the deaf man with the speech impediment in Gentile land. As Jesus brings healing to the man, he utters the word **Ephphatha!**, which means, **Be opened!** Jesus is providing the man an opening to return to the community through the healing. Jesus is also inviting the crowd to be open to the healing that comes through following him. As we hear these words, we are called to be open to all that Christ shares with us through our faith. *What are we being invited to "be open" to in our lives?*

Our parish campaign, **Celebrating our Faith – Continuing our Vision**, is well underway. Thanks to those who have already supported the campaign by making a pledge. If you have not yet made a pledge, please prayerfully consider the financial request included in the letter from me. In the coming weeks, many of our volunteers will continue to set up personal meetings with some of you. Please be responsive to their request if you receive a call. This will include a walking tour with information stops of the spaces impacted by the proposed projects in our parish campaign. The tour will begin in the Mulligan Room. 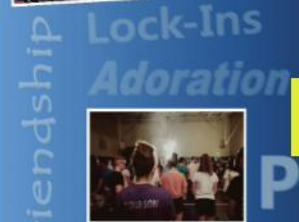


