



The Gospel for this Fourth Sunday of Lent contains the famous passage from John 3:16 - For God so loved the world.... but it also has Jesus saying to Nicodemus: Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. Jesus is making a connection to his own death on the Cross and the fact that he will be lifted up for the salvation of all, a true example of God's great love for us. We are also reminded in this passage that through our belief in Jesus we will share in the gift of eternal life, for God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Through Jesus, the true light has been revealed to us and we are invited to turn away from darkness and live in the light.

This Fourth Sunday of Lent is also known as *Laetare Sunday*. Laetare means "*Rejoice*" and helps set a tone of joyful anticipation in a season that is otherwise focused on repentance and preparation. As we get closer to the celebration of the Easter mystery, let us always remember that there is reason for us to rejoice!

Thanks to everyone who supported our recent Hope-In-Motion service project, Crazy Cash Giveaway, and second collection to support those in need through our partnership with Catholic Charities. We are grateful for your generosity and participation.

We also continue our "Blessing Box" Lenten service project to support education scholarships for young people in our sister community in El Salvador. The contributions to your home blessing box can be combined into one check written to Presentation at the end of Lent. All contributions help support the scholarship students throughout the year. Please be generous.

This week we celebrate two great models of faith, **St. Patrick** (March 17) and **St. Joseph** (March 19). **St. Patrick** was an imprisoned slave who escaped back to his native Britain. But he felt called to go back and convert the Irish people to Christianity. He became a priest and bishop and died on March 17, 461. Whether we




