The Gospel we hear on this Third Sunday of **Easter** is the final Resurrection appearance story that is contained in Luke's Gospel. Again, when Jesus appears to the disciples, he extends to them the greeting of: Peace be with you. Although the disciples are startled and terrified, Jesus is persistent in wanting them to know that it is truly him. He says: Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ahost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have. Jesus wants them to share in the joy of his Resurrection. As he eats in front of them, he reminds them that all that has been spoken about him has been fulfilled and that they are witnesses of these things. We are called to be witnesses of Christ's Resurrection by the way we share our faith and become signs of hope and new life for others. Let us be attentive to the ways Christ is made known to us and be eager to share His Presence with others.





## Ministerio Hispano

Hermanos que Cristo nos permita reconocerle resucitado. En el Evangelio de Hoy, Jesús abre la mente de los discípulos al misterio de su muerte y resurrección y les dice: "Ustedes son testigos de todo esto". Los Apóstoles, que vieron con los propios ojos a Cristo resucitado, no podían callar su extraordinaria experiencia. Él se había mostrado ante ellos para que la verdad de su resurrección llegara a todos mediante su testimonio. El Senor nos prepara y después nos envía como testigos. Por eso, la Iglesia tiene la tarea de prolongar en el tiempo y en la historia esta misión; cada bautizado está llamado a dar testimonio, con las palabras y con la vida, de que Jesús ha resucitado, que Jesús está vivo y presente en medio de nosotros.

Podemos preguntarnos: pero, ¿quién es el testigo? El testigo es uno que ha visto, que recuerda y cuenta. Ver, recordar y contar son los tres verbos que describen la identidad y la misión. El testigo es uno que ha visto, con ojo objetivo, ha visto una realidad, pero no con ojo indiferente; ha visto y se ha dejado involucrar por el acontecimiento. Por eso recuerda, no solo porque sabe reconstruir en modo preciso los hechos sucedidos, sino también porque aquellos hechos le han hablado y él ha captado el sentido profundo. Entonces el testigo cuenta, no de manera fría y distante sino como uno que se ha dejado poner en cuestión y desde aquel día ha cambiado de vida.

El contenido del testimonio cristiano no es una teoría, no es una ideología o un complejo sistema de preceptos y prohibiciones o un moralismo, sino que es un mensaje de salvación, un acontecimiento concreto, es más, una Persona: es Cristo resucitado, viviente y único Salvador de todos. Por eso recuerda el Santo Padre el Papa Francisco que Él puede ser testimoniado por auienes experiencia hecho una personal de Él, en la oración y en la Iglesia, a través de un camino aue tiene su fundamento en el



Bautismo, su alimento en la Eucaristía, su sello en la Confirmación, su continúa conversión en la Penitencia.
