

James and John in today's Gospel say to Jesus: Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you. When they ask to sit one at his left and the other at his right, Jesus quickly reminds them this will entail a willingness to follow his path, a path that includes suffering and giving one's life. And then Jesus goes further by reminding them that true discipleship is not about having the place of honor, but rather about giving oneself away in service whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant. Jesus says: for the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve. Sometimes we can get it backwards. We think we are entitled to "being served" because of our status, title, or sense of privilege. But everyone who says they are a disciple of Jesus is called to be a servant. Jesus is inviting us to share in his way of greatness. What are some ways we can shine forth the greatness of Jesus in our lives today?





Cuando alguien quiere ser admitido a una empresa o aceptado en un buen trabajo o cargo público, suele pedir una buena "recomendación" a amigos influyentes o bien acomodados... Parece que eso ha funcionado siempre así por la costumbre –no sé si buena o mala— de la gente. Pero el caso es que en tiempos de nuestro Señor sucedía también así. ¡Costumbres inveteradas!

Este domingo el Evangelio nos presenta a dos de los apóstoles, Juan y Santiago, pidiendo a Jesús una "recomendación" jy vaya recomendación! Diríamos nosotros que "se volaron la barda". Le piden nada menos que sentarse uno a su derecha y el otro a su izquierda en su Reino. ¡Nada ambiciosos estos muchachos! Se imaginaban que muy pronto su Maestro sería proclamado y reconocido públicamente como el Mesías de Israel por las autoridades judías y, en consecuencia, quieren asegurarse ya desde ahora un "buen puesto" en su Reino. Tal vez aspiraba uno ser el Ministro de Exteriores y el otro de Gobernación, o algo parecido....

Pero lo más genial de todo es la respuesta del Señor y el desenlace. No los reprende abiertamente, tal vez porque también descubría en ellos buena voluntad y deseos sinceros de estar junto a Él. Pero sí aprovecha para darles una gran lección. "¿Serán capaces de beber el cáliz que yo he de beber, o de bautizarse con el bautismo con el que yo me voy a bautizar?"

Pero nuestro Señor les dice a sus dos apóstoles que si quieren un cargo deben soportar el camino de la cruz, y les dice: sufrirán y padecerán el martirio, y les aclara que el lugar de honor, Ése ya está reservado por el Padre.

Pero eso no es todo. Jesús añade: el que quiera ser

grande, que sea el servidor de todos; y el que quiera ser el primero, que sea esclavo de todos". Y les pone su propio ejemplo: "Fíjense en mí, pues yo no he venido para que me sirvan, sino para servir y para dar mi vida por todos".

¡Cuántas veces nosotros queremos sentirnos importantes y que la gente nos reconozca o que nos asignen puestos de honor y dignidad! Pues Cristo no ha venido para eso, y quienes nos llamamos y somos sus discípulos, tenemos que seguir el mismo camino de humildad, de caridad y de servicio. Él es el primero en darnos ejemplo: Él ha venido a servirnos y a dar su propia vida para salvarnos.
