At first, the crowd in today's Gospel tried to silence the blind beggar, Bartimaeus, who on hearing that Jesus was passing by began to cry out: **Jesus, son of David, have pity on me.** Like the crowd, it is easy for us sometimes to dismiss the needs of the poor and needy among us and try to silence their cries for help. But Jesus insists that Bartimaeus' needs be heard. So the same crowd says to him: **Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you.** Once in the presence of Jesus, Bartimaeus is asked: **What do you want me to do for you?** He says: **Master, I want to see.** Jesus recognizes the faith of Bartimaeus and his willingness to be a disciple and says to him: **Go your way; your faith has saved you.** Bartimaeus could see more clearly who Jesus was than even those closest to him. May our eyes be opened to see Jesus, especially in the needy among us.

This weekend is the kick-off for our Diocesan **Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA)**. All registered households should receive a mailing from the diocese that explains all of the programs and services that are supported through the ACA. The appeal benefits all of our parishes and all the people of our diocese. Please consider a financial gift to the ACA. A video from the Bishop about the ACA can also be found on our website. Each parish is given a goal to reach for the appeal, so your contributions help us reach that goal. Thank you for your generosity.

Next Sunday, October 31, we will celebrate our annual **Masses of Remembrance** at the **8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Masses** for those who have died this past year. Family members of those from our parish who died this past year and parishioners who have notified us of a family member death this past year were all sent postcards to RSVP for one of the Masses. The Masses will include a candle procession. We welcome those who will be joining us for this beautiful remembrance of our deceased loved ones.

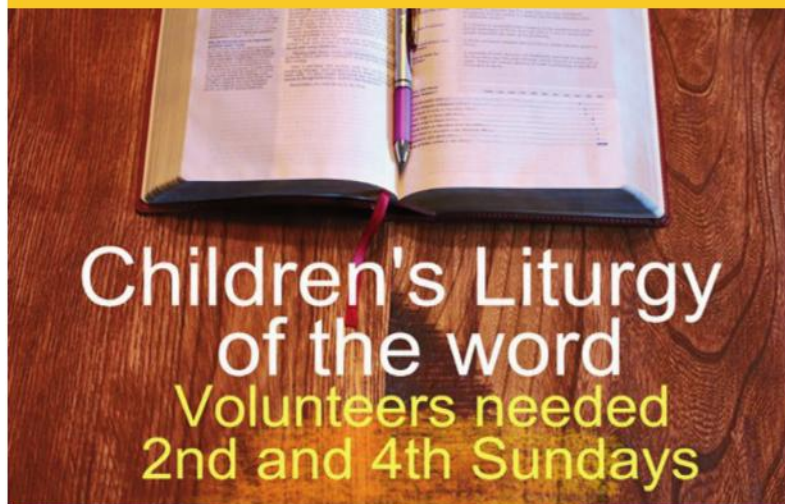

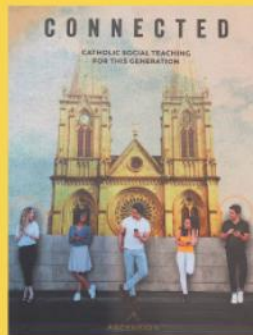

Hermanos que el Señor Jesús nos haga recobrar la vista para ver con ojos de Fe y así cambiar las realidades de este mundo.

Bartimeo quería algo y lo pidió con todas sus fuerzas, incluso gritando. Jesús no pudo seguir adelante, porque había alguien junto al camino que le necesitaba y que hacía lo posible para ser escuchado; entonces le llamó, y el ciego, arrojando todo lo que tenía se puso en pie y se acercó a Jesús.

Nos encontramos ante una lección perfecta de cómo orar y de cómo acercarnos a Jesús. Primero hay que pedir con insistencia y con fuerza, que Cristo nos socorra, y hay que hacerlo con la actitud del ciego: con humildad y confianza.
