# Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel for this weekend begins with Jesus saying: **Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.** Jesus is reminding us that he is the fulfillment of all God's promises, which are rooted in God's law of love. Jesus, in essence, is calling us to a higher standard of living and inviting us to choose a way of life that leads us closer to God. Jesus wants us to go beyond outward appearances and external actions and examine what is in our hearts, like anger or lust. Our internal dispositions are often the cause of our outward sins. While we are human and at times weak, we do have the strength of Christ with us. Let us call upon him to help us attain our higher calling and live with the dignity God intends

This weekend the Church observes **World Marriage Sunday**. This is always the weekend closest to St. Valentine's Day. As we celebrate the gift of marriage, we ask God to bless all marriages so that they may be fruitful expressions of God's love. 


