# Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel for this 1st Sunday of Lent is the familiar story of Jesus being led out into the desert and being tempted by the devil. From the story, we get the traditional length for the season of Lent as it corresponds to Jesus fasting for forty days and forty nights in the desert. Jesus resists the temptations presented to him by arming himself with the Word of God and the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus reminds us that the battle between good and evil is real. But he gives us the tools to trust that goodness will always win out and he models for us how to overcome the temptation to evil. Jesus does not give in to the easy way out but rather holds firm in his faith. As we enter the desert of Lent, what temptations in our lives do we need to reduce to dust? During these forty days of fasting and praying, let us place our trust in God and find strength in the goodness of our faith. May we find "holy moments" throughout our Lenten journey.

Please be sure to pick up a copy of our **Lenten Daily Prayer booklet**, which includes daily scripture, reflection and activities that build on our PRAY-FAST-GIVE theme for Lent. The booklet also contains information about the various happenings during Lent and Holy Week. We hope you will take advantage of these opportunities for prayer and faith enrichment.

A great commitment to make during Lent is to attend **daily Mass**. Please remember that during Lent, in addition to our regular 8:15 a.m. daily Mass, we add a 6:30am Mass on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

We also have several opportunities during the week and weekend to celebrate the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**. Please see the bulletin or Lenten prayer booklet for all the times.

And don't forget to join us for **Stations of the Cross** every Friday of Lent at 6:30 p.m. in church. There are a variety of ways we pray the Stations, so make a commitment to join us. You can also enjoy our delicious **Fish Fry** every Friday of Lent from 5:00-7:00 p.m. We are grateful to the Knights of Columbus for sponsoring our weekly Fish Fry.

One of our annual Lenten service projects is the **Lenten Blessing Boxes.** You can create a container in your home for your Lenten almsgiving and use the resources provided each week in the bulletin to assist your journey. At the end of Lent, you can donate the money collected in your container or write a check in the amount to Presentation. All contributions raised through the Blessing Boxes will be used to support our **sister community in El Salvador** through student scholarships.



## Adult Faith Formation recommends films for your Lenten journey

Looking for a thoughtful film with faith themes? Here's a curated list to get you started.

## 1 THE WAY(2010)

Martin Sheen leads the cast as they walk El Camino de Santiago. The stories and experiences the characters share reveal much about people's struggles and the power of prayer and community to lighten the burdens.

## **2** CHOCOLAT (2000)

Johnny Depp, Juliette Binoche, Judi Dench star in a plot that shakes up the rigid beliefs of a small French town, opening them to love for each other. The bonus is the fabulous soundtrack.

## 3 HENRY POOLE IS HERE (2008)

Luke Wilson and George Lopez (in a surprising non-comedic role) star in this film that places isolation and community in opposition to each other and reveals the surprising nature of faith.

## 4 THE APOSTLE (1997)

Robert Duvall stars and directs this story of a Pentecostal preacher whose encounter with sin (of the mortal kind) leads him to self-exploration as he ministers to others while on the run.

## 5 JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR (1973 AND 2019)

Andrew Lloyd Weber's classic musical of Jesus at the time of his betrayal and passion. Watch the original or the 2019 "live for tv" version with John Legend and Alice Cooper.

## 🔓 A RIVER RUNS THROUGH IT (1992)

Based on the semi-autobiographical novella by Maclean, the story follows two sons of a Presbyterian minister, one studious and the other rebellious, with strong themes of family and forgivness.. Starring Tom Skerritt and Brad Pitt.

## 7 A BEAUTIFUL DAY IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD (2019)

Based on the true story of a real-life friendship between Fred Rogers and journalist Tom Junod. It's a thoughtful, textured contemplation of how we can effectively deal with our expectations, disappointments, and imperfections.

## 8 THE QUEEN OF KATWE (2016)

A true story of a young girl from the streets of rural Uganda whose world rapidly changes when she is introduced to the game of Chess. Despite her family's poverty and its inherent challenges, she succeeds because of her choices.

## 9 SOUL (2014)

What is it that makes you...YOU? Soul explores the meaning of life, beyond our personal ambitions, and the reality that we are created to enjoy life and care for others. Enjoy the music by Jon Batiste.

## 10 THE BOY WHO HARNESSED THE WIND (2022)

Against all the odds, a thirteen-year-old boy in Malawi invents an unconventional way to save his family and village from famine. Based on a true story.

## SHADOWLANDS (1993)

This British biographical drama film is about the relationship between C. S. Lewis (played by Anthony Hopkins) and Joy Davidman (played by Debra Winger), her death from cancer, and how this challenged his Christianity.






