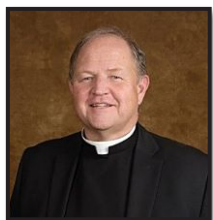

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus opens the eyes of a man born blind. The story begins with the disciples asking Jesus: **Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?** Jesus quickly dispels this commonly held belief of his time by saying that neither sinned. The mercy of God that Jesus shares turns everything upside down and allows those who experience it to see everything differently. Jesus goes further by saying that the **works of God** will be made visible through the healing of the blind man and help reveal Jesus as the **light of the world**. This powerful story is an invitation for all of us to see with the eyes of faith. Most of us will never have to deal with physical blindness. We often take our physical sight for granted, but spiritual blindness is something that affects all of us at times. This season of Lent is a time for our eyes to be opened so that we may recognize the presence of Jesus in our midst.

This **Sunday, March 19**, marks another important day in our Church – the **Feast of St. Joseph**. Although his feast day does not take precedence over the Sunday in Lent, it is still a time to celebrate Joseph as the earthly father of Jesus and the righteous man who upheld the dignity of Mary in a difficult situation. As protector and provider for the Holy Family, Joseph is a model of humility and faith. St. Joseph is the patron of the Universal Church, workers, and fathers. Let us call upon the intercession of St. Joseph to help us build up God's kingdom through the work of our hands.

Our parish is honoring St. Joseph this Sunday with our **St. Joseph Table** and pasta meal. The table blessing will be at 11:00 a.m. and the meal will be served from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. In keeping with tradition, all proceeds from the event will go to help those in need. Please plan to join us.

This **Monday, March 20**, we will gather for our **Lenten Reconciliation Service** at 6:30 p.m. in the church. All of us are encouraged to take advantage of this sacrament of forgiveness as we prepare ourselves for the joy of Christ's Resurrection. There will be several priests here to assist with individual confessions. Below is a short reflection on the sacrament that may be helpful:

In the sacrament of Reconciliation God humbly confesses his love for us and we humbly confess our need for that love and the confidence it brings. We confess our desire to be at home in the sanctuary of pure love. When we are aware of God's love we cannot help but share that love. God's love is so powerful and immense that we cannot keep it to ourselves. Our awareness of God's love will naturally transform our lives. It will naturally affect all our relationships. This is why we celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation in the community.

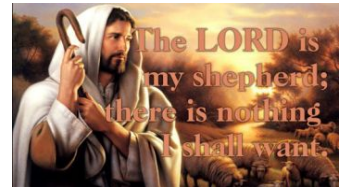

Leatare es una palabra del idioma latín (alégrate) y es por eso que el cuarto domingo de la cuaresma toma ese nombre. La palabra leatare es la primera palabra del introductorio para la misa del cuarto domingo de cuaresma "leatare Jerusalem" tomado del libro del profeta

Isaías 66,10.

Diferentes culturas y diferentes tradiciones se refieren a este domingo con diferentes nombres, entre ellos, domingo maternal, domingo refrescante, domingo de la cintura de la cuaresma, (en francés mi-carême), y domingo de rosa, ya sea por la rosa de ora que el papa les manda a los soberanos o por el color rosa que se usa ese día envés del color morado.

Es curioso que este año 2023 el día de san José 19 de marzo cae en el cuarto domingo de cuaresma y que dentro de 11 años en 2034 otra vez el día de san José caerá el cuarto domingo de cuaresma y otra vez en otros 11 años en 2045 pero estas serán las únicas ocasiones por lo menos en este siglo.

El domingo de la alegría es un grito de esperanza en este tiempo de penitencia cuando Jesús nos dice a nosotros también alégrate mi resurrección esta cerca. Si escuchamos su voz es claro, pero si no este domingo en particular está lleno de simbolismo y uno de ellos es el color rosa. De los nombres que anteriormente mencione creo que son algo nuevo para algunos de nosotros, pero

lo que sí es evidente y más notorio es el color de las vestimentas que los sacerdotes y diacono visten el cuarto domingo de cuaresma.

Que la alegría de este domingo nos dure hasta el día de la resurrección del señor Jesús para que nos de la energía y la gracia necesaria durante la semana santa que recordaremos y aremos vida su sufrimiento, el pago que el pago por nuestra salvación.
