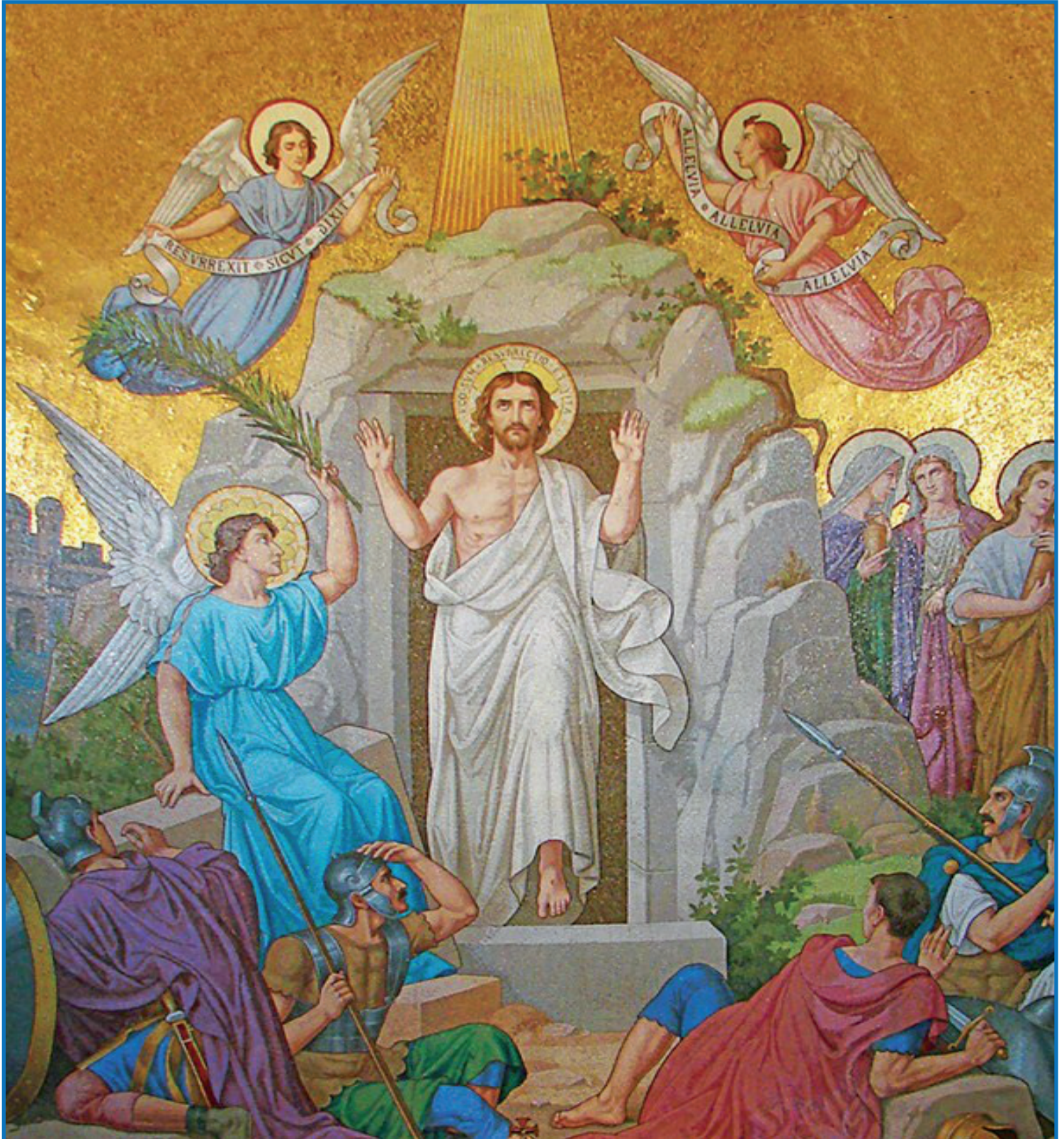

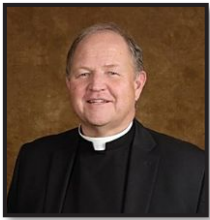

Our voices proclaim **ALLELUIA** for the **LORD IS TRULY RISEN!** As we gather together this Easter Sunday weekend, we celebrate the central belief of our Christian faith – that Christ came forth from the tomb to share with us the gift of eternal life. 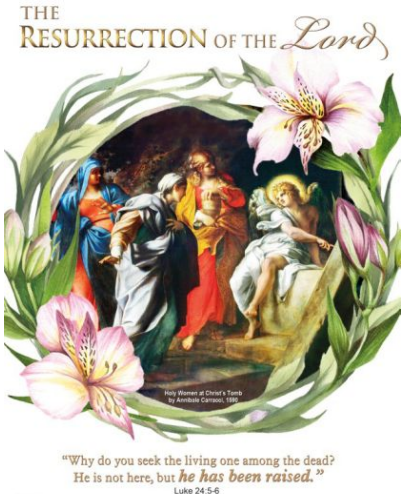

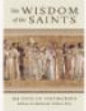

Report Abuse

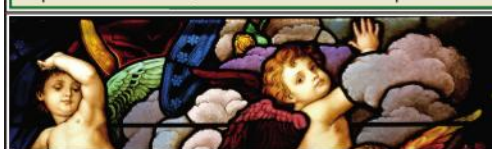
