Thoughts from Fr. Tom

This **Fourth Sunday of the Easter season** is traditionally referred to as **Good Shepherd Sunday**. While we honor Jesus as the Good Shepherd, this year's Gospel also uses the image of Jesus as the gate for the sheep. We hear Jesus say: *Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved. Jesus invites us to enter into life with him. And listening to his voice and following his way will lead to life eternal. Jesus is always there to open the gate for us. All we need to do is listen and follow.*

The **month of May** is a special time when our Church celebrates our **Blessed Mother, Mary**. There will be several things happening throughout the month in honor of Mary. This Wednesday the children from our school and evening CFF religious education program will be participating in May Crowning ceremonies. Next weekend, May 6-7, we will Crown the statue of our Blessed Mother at the beginning of each Mass. The following weekend, May 13-14, is Mother's Day weekend. We will have Mother's Day carnations available to honor both our living and deceased mothers. Please be sure to return your **Mother's Day envelope** before May 13-14 with the name of your mother and a contribution in her honor so that the envelope can be included in our procession and prayers that weekend. May 13 is also the Anniversary of the appearance of Mary at Fatima. There will be a special **Fatima Rosary** prayed outside by our Mary Garden on the north side at 11am that day. We will also be praying the Rosary before each weekend Mass throughout the month, so please arrive a little as we pray together for Mary's intercession.

Next weekend, May 6-7, is one of our designated monthly collections for the **FUTURE PROJECTS FUND**. We are hoping to tackle some significant projects this summer, one of which is to expand our parking lot on the north side while making other parking lot improvements. We could really use everyone's support of the Future Projects Fund, especially over the next several months, so that we can complete these projects without depleting our reserves too much. With everyone's help we can accomplish much. Please be generous.

Congratulations to the teens from our parish who received the **Sacrament of Confirmation** this past Monday. Please keep these youth in your prayers as they find ways to use their gifts in good and meaningful ways. 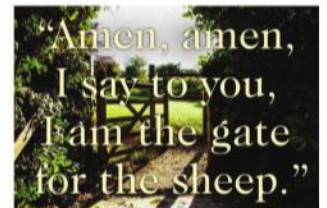

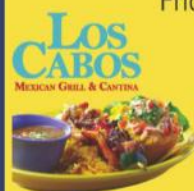

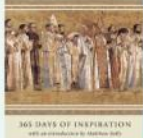
Early Childhood Center

El camino de la Pascua

A lo largo de estos 50 días asta llegar al domingo de pentecostés estamos reflexionando sobre el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, como Vivian las primeras comunidades cristianas y como la Iglesia se extendía por todo el mundo, vemos desde ya la acción del Espíritu Santo.

Los sacramentos son una extensión de la misericordia de Dios para con nosotros los pecadores, y de entre los siete sacramentos hay unos que se disfruta mas celebrarlos por la atracción visual. Por ejemplo, el bautizo con sus tres elementos fundamentales, la persona, el agua, y la formula. La verdad es emocionante ver como las familias completas preparan y celebran un bautismo; para mi también es emocionante llegar a la pila bautismal y ver las personas que esperan ser bautizadas y mas aun me llena de emoción pronuncia y decir la formula bautismal en nombre de nuestra madre Iglesia "Fulano de tal Yo te bautizo en el Nombre del Padre, y Del Hijo, y Del Espíritu Santo, Amen"

Vemos en la primera lectura un claro ejemplo del príncipe de los apóstoles, San Pedro, como les predica a la gente, los evangeliza, les dice que hacer para salvarse y heredar el reino de Dios. Luego dice que ese mismo día mas de tres mil personas se bautizaron. Ese mismo día el Espíritu Santo actuó y les abrió la posibili-

dad de la salvación a mas personas en nombre del Mesías, Jesús de Nazaret.

Ahora solo resta recordar que hay que identificar al pastor, por que muchos vendrán diciendo que ellos son los pastores, pero en realidad son lobos feroces y que solo conducen a la muerte. Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas no se dejen llevar solo por puros sentimientos o palabras bonitas, busquen he identifiquen la verdad.


