

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord. For several years now, in most dioceses in the United States it is no longer celebrated as a holy day on a Thursday but now takes the place of the Seventh Sunday of Easter so that more people can share in this important feast. The Ascension reminds us that Jesus returned to his rightful place in heaven but his Ascension also makes possible a new way for him to be present to the disciples through the promised gift of the Holy Spirit. The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles provides some details of the event as he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. But the reading ends with the promise that Jesus will return. The Gospel from Matthew makes no mention of Jesus' Ascension but highlights his great commission as he tells the disciples to Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations... He then ends by saying: I am with you always, until the end of the age. As we celebrate Jesus' Ascension, let us ascend with him through the ways we live and share our faith and trust that he is with us always.

Report Abuse

- 1. Call the Missouri Child Abuse Hotline, 1-800-392-3738 (if the victim is currently under the age of 18), and
- 2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or call 911, and
- 3. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, 816-812-2500, or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.


