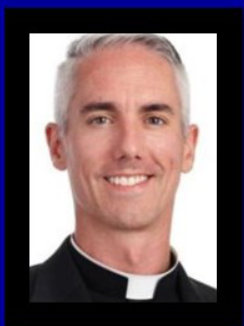

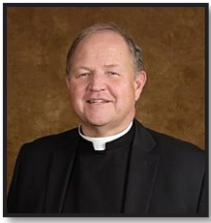

## Thoughts from Fr. Tom

**God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.** This scripture passage we hear in today's Gospel, **John 3:16**, is one of the more recognizable and well known as it is often publicized at sporting events and other public gatherings. This passage is so popular because it reveals the heart of the Christian message – that God's love for us has been poured out through the gift of Jesus. Although the Easter season ended last weekend, we continue to celebrate how through the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus the love of God is revealed to us in new ways. At the heart of the **Feast of the Most Holy Trinity** we celebrate today is the mystery of the Trinity as a relationship of love between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While we may never fully understand this mystery, it is expressed simply through love. Our journey of faith is an invitation to be drawn ever more closely into this circle of love.

We offer a special **blessing to all our graduates** at the Masses this weekend. Congratulations to graduates of all ages and grade levels. We are proud of your accomplishments and ask God's continued blessing upon you as you move forward on life's journey and enter new schools and careers.

**Father's Day weekend** is June 17-18. You can honor your living or deceased father by including their name on the **Father's Day envelope** found in your June packet or by filling out your own envelope marked Father's Day. You may also fill out the online form by going to the Online Giving tab on our website. We will include these envelopes and names in our entrance processions and prayers at Masses that weekend.
