

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, often referred to as Corpus Christi. As we hear Jesus say in the Gospel: I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever. This feast reminds us of the powerful gift of Christ's presence in the Eucharist and the promise of eternal life that Christ offers us. Our participation in the Eucharist is essential to our faith and helps us recognize Jesus as the true Bread from Heaven and the source of our salvation. As we receive the Eucharist at Mass, let us always recognize the powerful gift being shared with us.

The Church in the United States has been focused on a 3-year **Eucharistic Revival** to help strengthen the belief of the faithful in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This last year of the revival has an emphasis on parish life and ways we can foster the importance of the Eucharist in our daily lives. At Presentation, we are offering a series on the Eucharist by Bishop Barron every Thursday in June. All are welcome to join us on the remaining two Thursdays.

Although participation in the Eucharist on the weekend should always be a priority, we also offer daily Mass and Eucharistic Adoration during the week. These are great ways to be in the presence of the Lord and grow in your faith life. Try one or both and see what a difference it makes in your life.

Also, this Sunday, June 11, you can join in the **Corpus Christi procession** beginning about 3:00 p.m. We will start in church and weather permitting, have a short procession around our campus and then return to church for a period of Adoration. It will last about one hour. Please take advantage of all the ways we offer to deepen your faith and trust in the Eucharist.

Next weekend is **Father's Day weekend**. We will offer a **special blessing** for fathers at all the Masses. Please be sure to return the **Father's Day envelope** included in your June packet or fill out your own envelope marked Father's Day and return by the end of the week. You can also use Online Giving. We will include these envelopes in our entrance processions and our prayers at Mass.

Next weekend we will also welcome Fr. Lawrence Tucker from the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity (SOLT) to give our annual **Missionary Appeal**. He will be preaching at all the Masses and there will be a second collection to support the work of their community. More information



Report Abuse
