Children's Faith Formation Programs

Sunday School (ages 3 1/2 - Kdg)



Children ages 3 1/2 (by Sept. 1) through kindergarten attend Sunday School during the 10:00 a.m. Mass from mid-September through the end of April. We use a Liturgical Year-based curriculum, Pflaum Gospel Weeklies, connecting the Sunday Gospel to the lives of the children and Church doctrine. **Online registration is open.** Rates increase August 1st.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based program where children grow in their relationship with God through a deep engagement in scripture and liturgy. We have a Level 1 Atrium for those 3 1/2 to 6 years old. The Atrium sessions are held once weekly during the school year. Registration available beginning August 18th.

CFF Wednesday Night



Children in grades 1-5, not enrolled in our parish school attend weekly sessions on Wednesday nights from mid-September through the first week of May. We use the *Discover* program published by St. Mary's Press where *The Catholic Children's Bible* is our core text and each lesson is filled with exciting and energetic learning. We meet 5:30 to 6:45 p.m. **Online registration is open.** Rates increase August 1st.

First Communion Preparation



The children of our Children's Faith Formation Program and Our Lady of the Presentation School prepare for and celebrate the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist typically in the second grade. Parents prepare their children for the sacraments with the support of the classroom teachers and monthly gatherings. **Online registration is open.**

Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children kindergarten through third grade are invited to participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word during Mass. The children are dismissed from the sanctuary to hear the Word of God proclaimed from the Children's Lectionary, then discussed and reflected upon at their level. **No registration is required.** Offered between September -April.



Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel this weekend continues with Jesus using various parables that reveal images for the kingdom of heaven. We hear that the kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field...like a merchant searching for fine pearls...like a net thrown into the sea, which collects fish of every kind. These parables stress the value of the kingdom of heaven and the importance of sacrificing all else in order to possess it. The image of the pearl reminds us that it is not enough to possess the pearl of faith, we have to "wear it" and share it. The image of the net reminds us that the kingdom is all-encompassing and that God wants all of us to share in this gift. Every day is an opportunity to recognize the treasure of our faith and find ways to share our treasure through lives committed to love and service. There are a myriad of things that try to get our attention in this world, lots of things before us that are shiny and flashy, but nothing is more valuable than our faith in Christ. Let us place our faith above all other things and allow our lives to shine forth this most precious of aifts.

News From El Salvador

Update from C.I.S.

We work with the *Center for Exchange and Solidarity (C.I.S.)* in El Salvador to sponsor 32 students. Here is an excerpt from their June newsletter continued from last week's bulletin:

Dear Friend.

...CIS is at the forefront accompanying innocent victims of the suspension of rights and getting their testimonies out to uncover a strong propaganda machine that gives an illusion that only criminals are arrested. CIS has a unique role in getting testimonies publicized because of the trust we have built in communities impacted by the policy. Government sources close to the CIS admit innocent victims. Socrro Juridico Humanitario, who the CIS is working closely with, estimates at least 20,000 innocent victims. People fear arrest or re-arrest if they speak out which is why the CIS work accompaniment is so important - to give a voice to the voiceless. CIS director has facilitated dozens of interviews to get the truth out. Articles have been published in seven important newspapers in El (4 online and 3 in print) that are not government propaganda. Additionally, CIS is doing interviews and facilitating interviews internationally: Univision, the New Yorker, the Progressive, Ignatian Solidarity Network,

America Magazine (USA), El Pals (Spain), The Telegraph (England), deVolkskrant (Holland), CHV Noticias (Chile), Nederlands Dagblad (Netherlands) and more. CIS has also provided legal support to 32 innocent victims, legal advice, food baskets, economic aid for expenses for trips to prison, necessity items for prisoners (not provided by the government), transportation, organizational meetings, and health care when people get out of prison.





Report Abuse

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph is committed to combatting sexual abuse in the Church. If you are a victim of sexual abuse, or if you observe or suspect sexual abuse:

- 2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or call 911, and


