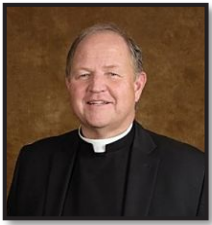

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

This weekend we celebrate the **Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord**. We hear the Gospel story of Jesus taking Peter, James, and John up a high mountain and being transfigured before them. **His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light**. This story of the Transfiguration is really a glimpse of the Resurrection. At first, Moses and Elijah appear with Jesus, but their presence is a reminder that Jesus is the fulfillment of the Law (Moses) and the prophets (Elijah). Jesus eventually stands alone as the beloved Son. We are called to listen to him. As the disciples fall down in fear at the sight of all that has happened, Jesus simply says: **Rise, and do not be afraid**. Those are words that all of us need to hear. Through Jesus, we have the strength to rise above our fears, to have hope in the midst of suffering, and to believe that life wins out over death. Our journey of faith is really about being “transfigured” into his image by the ways we follow him and imitate his love.

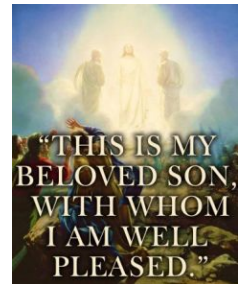

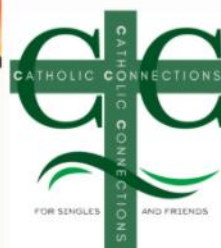

News From El Salvador

Update from C.I.S.

We work with the *Center for Exchange and Solidarity (C.I.S.)* in El Salvador to sponsor 32 students. Here is an excerpt from their June newsletter continued from last week's bulletin:

Dear Friend,

Not only are thousands arrested unjustly, but there are also grave human rights violations and torture inside the prisons. Innocent prisoners, who have been lucky enough to get out alive, leave malnourished, with profound anemia, scabies, lice, liver problems, high blood pressure, loss of between 40 and 90 pounds, dehydrated and other life-threatening illnesses. **Former prisoners tell CIS of beatings, tear gas, having been kept naked for a month, graves inside the prisons, and threats of being re-arrested if they speak out.** Ironically, gang members enjoy privileges and control inside the prisons. Prison guards put the gangs in charge of distributing what little food is allowed to enter from families of the innocent, which the gang members steal and consume before they get to the innocent prisoners. Even though the government is letting out innocent prisoners in droplets (5,000 to date), they are still considered criminals and out on parole and must check in with authorities every 15 days. **Survivors are comparing the situation to Auschwitz as they count the ribs on prisoners, and to the Gulag Archipelago with mass arrests and threats to those who speak out of being re-arrested.**

Not only is CIS helping to shed light on the reality within El Salvador and internationally, CIS has also been successful through legal support in getting 10 of 32 innocent people out of prison. While we still have a long way to go, each life and freedom is celebrated by all and gives hope to those families who still have loved ones in jail.
