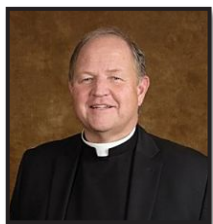

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In the Gospel today, Jesus acknowledges that sin exists among members of the community and that people will hurt one another. But instead of holding grudges or holding on to anger, Jesus offers some helpful steps for **conflict resolution**. Start by dealing with things one-on-one, if that doesn't work, involve one or two others, if that doesn't work, then tell the church. Only as a last resort is the person who has done the hurtful act to be treated as an outsider. And remember how Jesus treated outsiders? He welcomed them and extended God's mercy and love to them. The important thing in Jesus' eyes is that members of the community be reconciled and all feel valued by one another. Although not easy to follow, think how many conflicts and hurts could be cleared up if we were willing to listen to Jesus' instruction. The church, the community of believers, is supposed to be such a powerful reflection of God's love that Jesus says: **For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.** We should never forget to use the powerful tool of faith as we face conflicts and divisions in life. Let us remember that Christ is on our midst and go forth to imitate his love and mercy.

The annual **Parish Fiesta** is next Saturday, September 16. Tickets can still be purchased after Mass this weekend or at the Parish Office this week. Please join us in the north parking lot after the 4:30pm Mass next week and enjoy some great food and entertainment. You can also purchase food to go. We are grateful to the members of our Hispanic community who organize and plan this event.

Next weekend is also a Celebrating Stewardship weekend and **Nametag Sunday**. Please come a little early and join in the fun by filling out a nametag as you come to Mass next weekend.

One of the important outreach ministries of our parish is our relationship with our sister community of **San Rafael Cedros in El Salvador**. A small delegation of our parish members will be leaving this week to visit our sister community. This is a way for us to continue to build relationships with our brothers and sisters in El Salvador. Please pray for those who will be making the journey.

As a parish, one of the ways we provide financial support to the community is by funding **education scholarships** for young people to attend high school and college. Providing these scholarships over the years has been life changing for these young people. We will be taking up a second collection at all the Masses next weekend, **September 16-17**, for the scholarship fund. We have increased the number of scholarships we provide over the last few years, so your generosity is very much appreciated as we fulfill this commitment.
