Find ways to grow closer to Jesus – prayer, silence, reading the Gospel stories, song, loving others.


PERSEVERE

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The religious leaders in the Gospel today try to entrap Jesus by asking a question: ***Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?*** The intent of the question is to force him to make a choice between obedience to civil law or God's law. But Jesus turns things around on them. He doesn't engage in verbal sparring but simply invites them to ***repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.*** As we contemplate his response, we are reminded that in the end everything we have belongs to God. While we participate in society and use money and coins with the images of political figures, we recognize the blessings God has shared with us and strive to give back to God through lives of holiness. We might use this Gospel to reflect on how well we are giving back to God.

All registered households should have received the mailing from the diocese for the **Bishop's Annual Catholic Appeal**. Please support the work of our diocese which directly benefits all our parishes. The diocese has set our parish goal this year at about \$80,000. We need your help to reach the goal.

Beginning next weekend, we will kick-off our parish **Stewardship Renewal**. This is a great opportunity for all of us to make a commitment of our *time, talent, and treasure* and generously share our gifts with the parish. Please look for the mailing coming at the beginning of November.

Next weekend after the 4:30 p.m., 8:00 a.m., and 10:00 a.m. Masses we will host **New Parishioner Welcome** gatherings. We especially encourage those who have joined our parish in the past year to stop by the Mulligan Room after one of those Masses. This is an opportunity to meet staff and learn more about our parish community. We are grateful for all our new members.






