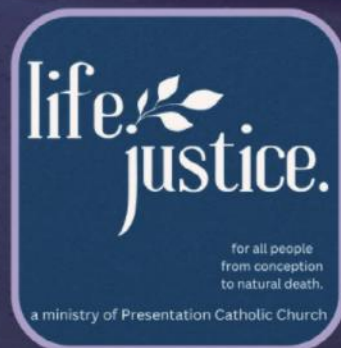

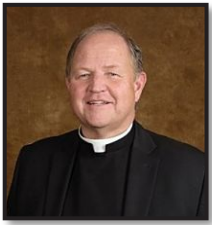

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel today invites us to reflect on the examples we follow in life. Jesus makes it clear to the crowds that they should observe what the scribes and Pharisees tell them but not follow their example. Jesus instead emphasizes the example of humble service that is modeled by his life. As we go through our day and our life, we should be constantly asking ourselves if we are following the right examples. The Gospel makes clear that service to one another in Christ's name is what leads to true greatness – **the greatest among you must be your servant**. Our society often gives us a different message about greatness and encourages us to seek wealth and status. It is easy to get seduced by this message and look for examples that reinforce this belief. But Jesus is always offering us another path. One that leads to true meaning and fullness of life. Which will we follow?

We extend a special welcome this weekend to those gathered with us who have lost a loved one this past year and those who are joining us for our **Remembrance Masses**. As we announce the names of the deceased, we lift them up in prayer and remember the bonds of love they have shared with us and trust that those bonds never die. At every funeral Mass we celebrate in the parish, one of the family members of the deceased places the name of their loved one in our **Book of Remembrance**. This is a way for our parish community to hold the deceased in our hearts and prayers throughout the year. As November is the **Month of the Dead** in our Church, the **Book of Remembrance** will be displayed throughout November by the baptismal font. You are invited to place the names of your deceased loved ones in the book and say a special prayer for the names listed on the pages.

Please remember that we are in the midst of our annual **Stewardship Renewal**. Over the next couple of weeks you will hear about the call to be good stewards of God's gifts and to reflect on ways you can **Encounter Joy** through the sharing of your gifts. We ask that you please take time to fill out the Stewardship Commitment card and to make a commitment of your **time, talent, and treasure** for the coming year. Please bring your card with you to Mass the weekend of **November 18-19** along with a new coat for our **Coat Drive** to support those served by our service partner, Bishop Sullivan Center. Please take time to prayerfully reflect on how God is calling you to share your gifts.

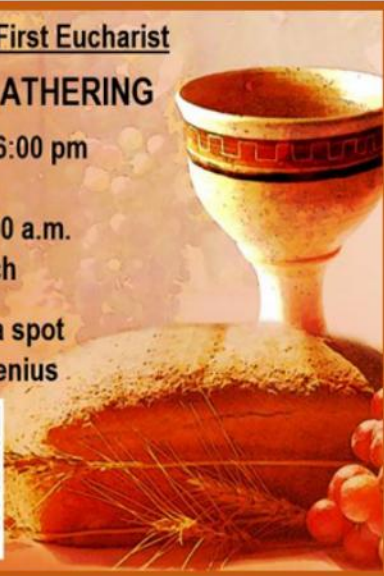
