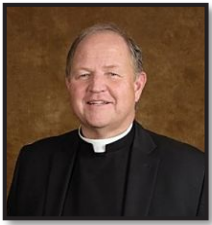

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel parable for today begins with these words: **A man going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. To one he gave five talents; to another two; to a third, one – each according to his ability.** As we reflect on how each of the servants used his talents, we are invited to examine our own lives and how we use the gifts and talents God has shared with us. God has blessed us all differently with our own unique gifts and talents, but God expects us to bear fruit with what we have been given. This parable is a great one to use with children because they get creative in finding ways to “multiply” their talents. As adults, are we being creative in the ways we use our God-given gifts so that God’s love and presence is multiplied in this world through our lives? Every day is an opportunity to share in our **master’s joy** by being good and faithful servants. May we always strive to bear the good fruit of our faith.

The Gospel today is a perfect one for our **Stewardship Commitment Weekend**. We are all called to share our unique gifts and talents to help build up God’s kingdom here in our parish. I hear stories over and over again about the joy people experience by getting involved in our various ministries and sharing generously with our community. I want to encourage you to share in the joy God brings to our lives by making a commitment to being a good steward of your *time, talent, and treasure*. Everything we have is a gift, so let’s give back with a spirit of gratitude. Let us give thanks for our faith community and all the blessings God has shared with us.

This is a **Celebrating Stewardship** weekend. Please be sure to stop by the tables in the Gathering Space and learn about some of the ministries active in our parish. You can pick up resources for the upcoming season of Advent, purchase coffee to support our sister community in El Salvador, and take a 2024 parish calendar home. You can also enjoy refreshments and fellowship with other parishioners.

We have much to be grateful for in our lives, so please join us for our special **Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00 a.m.** There is a designated envelope for Thanksgiving. 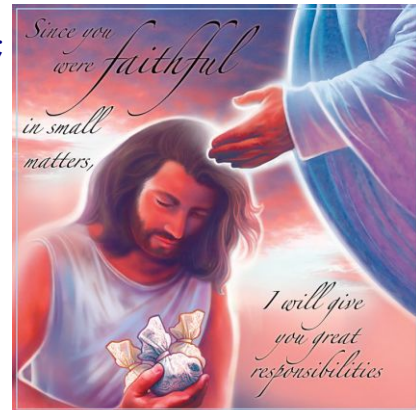

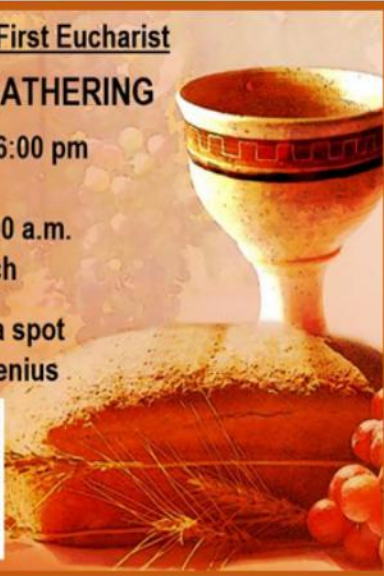

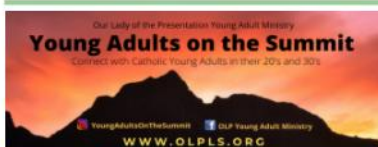

Report Abuse
