

# Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel parable for today begins with these words: A man going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. To one he gave five talents; to another two; to a third, one - each according to his ability. As we reflect on how each of the servants used his talents, we are invited to examine our own lives and how we use the aifts and talents God has shared with us. God has blessed us all differently with our own unique gifts and talents, but God expects us to bear fruit with what we have been given. This parable is a great one to use with children because they get creative in finding ways to "multiply" their talents. As adults, are we being creative in the ways we use our God-given gifts so that God's love and presence is multiplied in this world through our lives? 



#### **Report Abuse**
