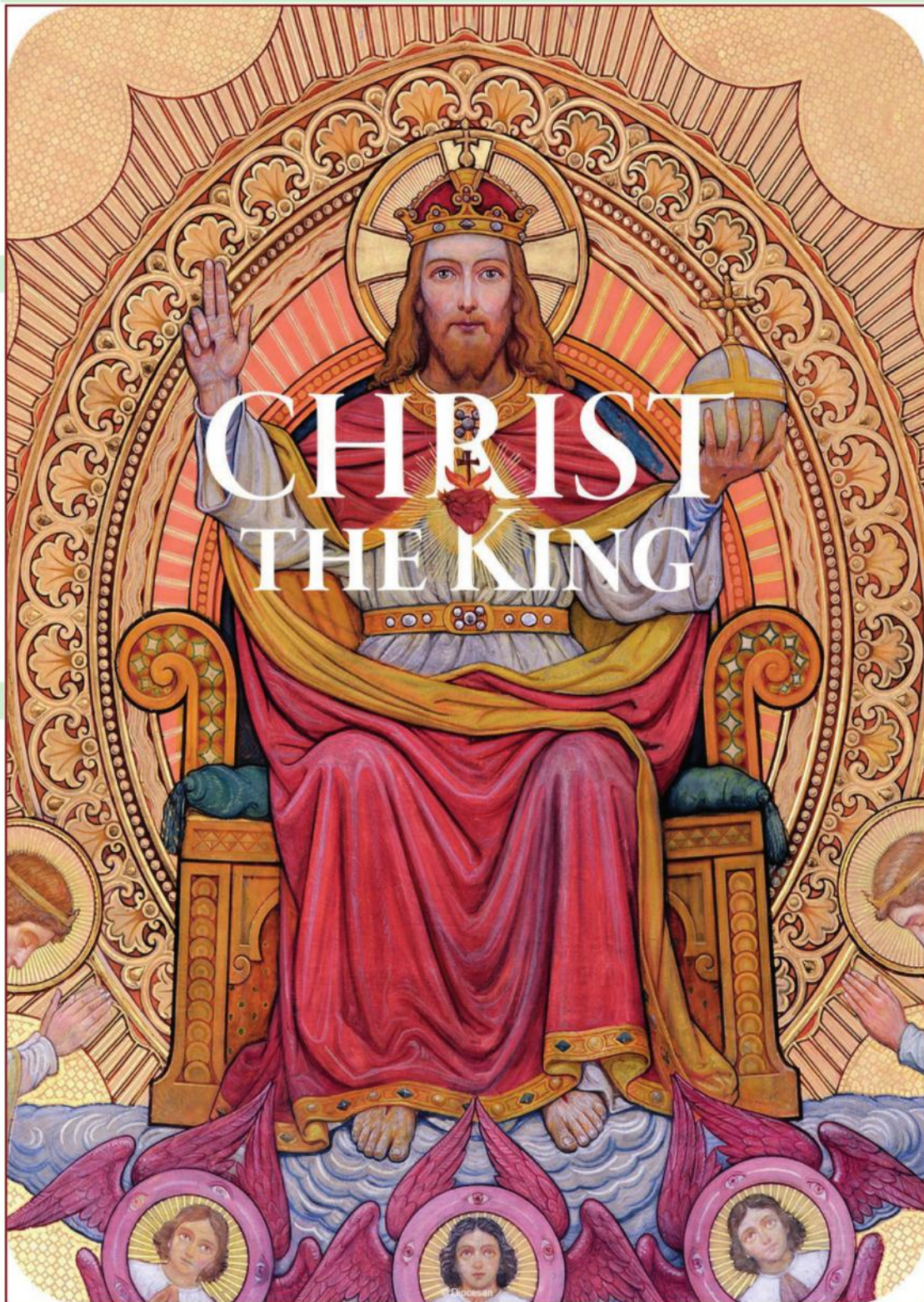

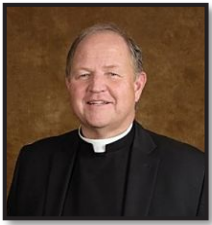

## Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Today is the Last Sunday in Ordinary Time which brings the liturgical year of the Church to a close. This celebration has become known as the **Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe**. 
