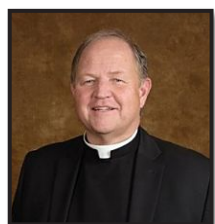

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Today we hear the calling of the first disciples from Mark's Gospel. Jesus calls two sets of brothers, Simon and Andrew and James and John. All are fishermen either casting or mending their nets. Jesus proclaims to them: ***This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.*** He then invites them to: ***Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.*** Jesus speaks to them with a sense of urgency and their response to Jesus is immediate. They leave everything behind to follow him. This Gospel should lead us to reflect on our willingness to follow Jesus. Most of us are not being asked to leave everything behind to follow him, but are we attentive to the daily ways we are called to be disciples and serve others? May our lives always be a reflection of our commitment to follow Christ.

This weekend is designated as **Word of God Sunday**. In 2019, on the liturgical memorial of the renowned biblical scholar St Jerome, Pope Francis announced that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time would be celebrated as the *Sunday of the Word of God*. The Pope went on to say *"we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers."* This is a great time to make a commitment to become more familiar with the Bible. Start with the Gospels and take time to read a chapter a day. There are many good resources available that make the Bible accessible. You can find resources on our parish website and at **www.usccb.org**. The new year is a great time to commit to making the Word of God active and alive in your life.

At the end of January every year we celebrate **Catholic Schools Week (CSW)**. This year we will kick off CSW at all the Masses next weekend, **January 27-28**. This is a great time to celebrate the gift of Catholic education in our community and thank our parishioners for their support throughout the year. As a parish, we will also be using CSW as a time to highlight our **OLP Endowment Fund for Catholic Education**. We have made good strides over the past several years in growing our parish school endowment and with your help we can continue in this direction. We are able to access a certain percentage of the endowment each year to provide financial assistance to school families in need. **There will be a second collection at all our Masses next weekend for our OLP Endowment.** Please use the designated envelope in your January packet, go to

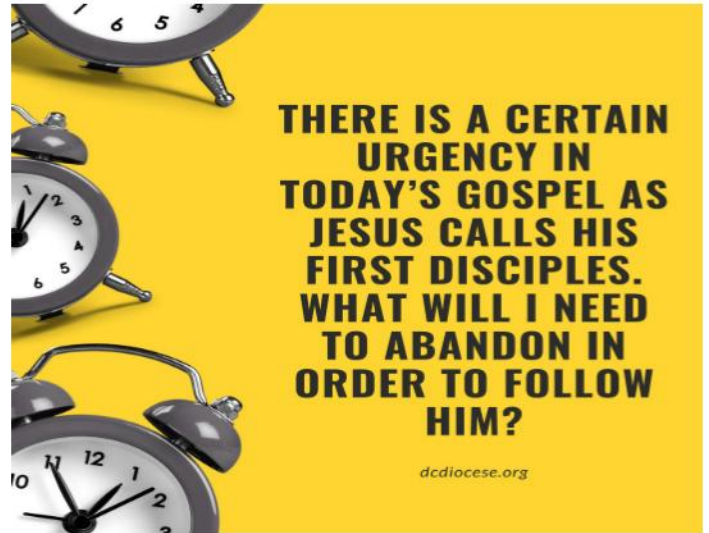

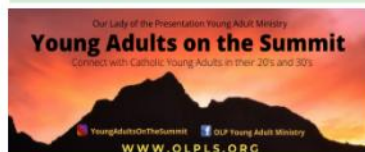
