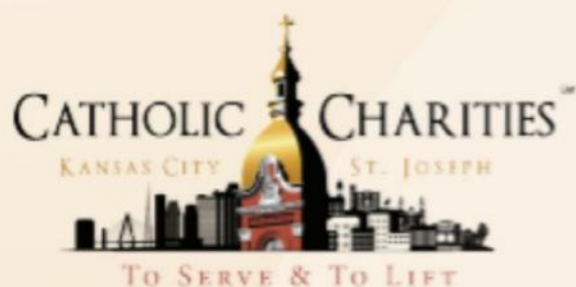

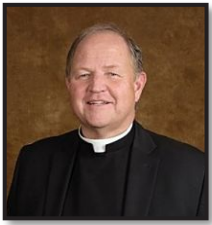

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In today's passage from the Gospel of Mark we hear the continuation of Jesus' healing ministry. He first performs an individual healing on the mother-in-law of Simon. After his healing touch, **the fever left her and she waited on them.** Her gratitude for the healing is immediately put into action through her service to others. Her example is a model for all of us to live with a spirit of gratitude and share it with others by lives committed to service. The Gospel continues, **while it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons and he cured many who were sick...and he drove out many demons.** After all this healing, Jesus **went off to a deserted place, where he prayed.** But after being told that the crowd was looking for him, Jesus is focused on the purpose for which he came and continues on to preach and heal in other villages. May we stay focused on our purpose to bring the healing love of Christ to others.

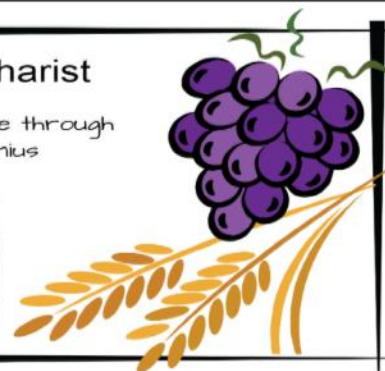

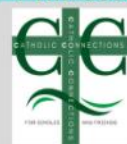

Wilber is 18 years old and began his second year of High School in January. He lives with his mother and 4 year-old sister. When asked “what impact has the scholarship program had on your life?” he replied:

It means a lot for my family that I have the opportunity to continue studying since they weren't given an opportunity like the one I have at the moment. I feel fortunate because, in this way, I can fight to get ahead in my life and fulfill my dreams. In this country, education is essential. Without studying, we youth face limitations in several aspects of life, principally in the workplace since many jobs are based on the level of education. So, I will fight for my future and that of my family in the community.
