

In today's passage from the Gospel of Mark we hear the continuation of Jesus' healing ministry. He first performs an individual healing on the mother-in-law of Simon. After his healing touch, the fever left her and she waited on them. Her gratitude for the healing is immediately put into action through her service to others. Her example is a model for all of us to live with a spirit of gratitude and share it with others by lives committed to service. The Gospel continues, while it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons and he cured many who were sick...and he drove out many demons. 


