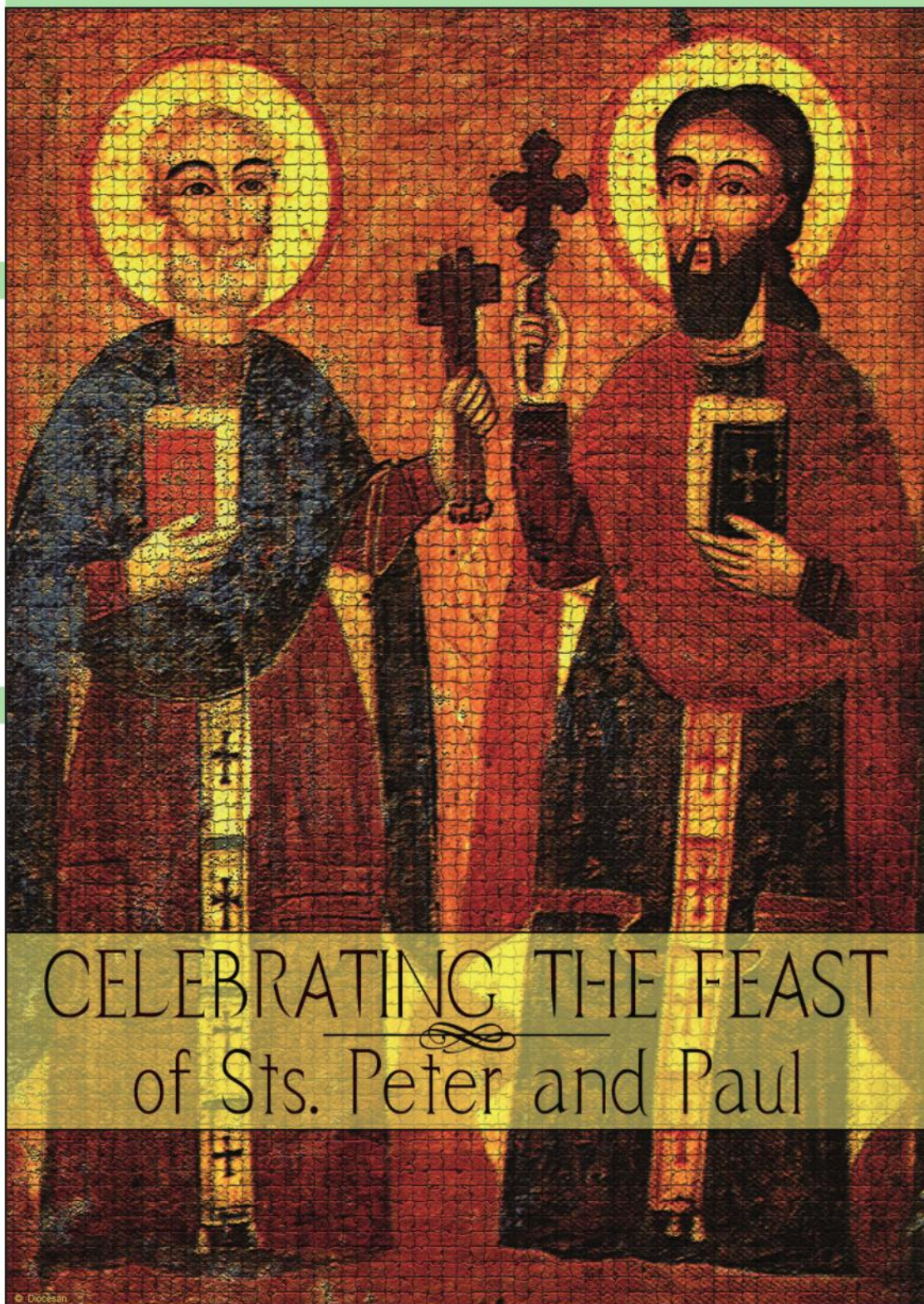

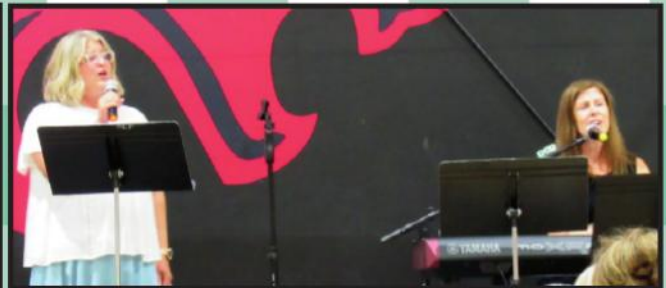

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Every year on June 29 the church celebrates the **Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles**. This year the feast falls on a Sunday so it takes precedence over the Sunday in Ordinary Time. This prominence reflects the influence Peter and Paul have had on the universal church. Next to Jesus, no other historical figures have made more of an impact in spreading the faith. The scriptures today reveal the witness of faith these two have provided over the centuries. In the first reading, Peter is freed from prison by an angel of the Lord so that he can continue to preach the good news. In the second reading, Paul speaks of his imminent death and how his strength comes from the Lord. In the Gospel, Jesus entrusts his flock to the care of Peter and says to him, **upon this rock I will build my Church**. As we honor Peter and Paul today, both martyrs for the faith, may the foundation they have provided continue to lead us to a deeper love for Christ and give us strength to lead others to Christ through our example.

This weekend we bid a fond farewell to **Fr. Angel**. Please take time after Mass this weekend to stop by the receptions and offer your personal thanks. We are grateful for the time Fr. Angel has spent with us and we know he will continue to share his gifts and faith in Jesus with his new parish of Our Lady of Peace. Thank you, Fr. Angel!
