# 10 Things We Love About the Gospel of Luke

1

## Everyone's Welcome

Jesus came to save all people, even Gentiles, women, Samaritans, tax collectors, prostitutes, the poor, the suffering, wealthy people, members of Herod's household, Zacchaeus up in a tree, and you.

2

## History

Luke includes names of emperors, kings, and governors. Much of what we know of Pontius Pilate comes from Luke. His accounting of the Herodian dynasty matches well with Jewish historian, Josephus.

3

## Great stories!

Of all the Gospel writers, Luke is the most skilled storyteller, including two unique parables that have become an essential part of secular culture: The Good Samaritan and The Prodigal Son.

4

## Rejoice!

According to Luke, the only response a redeemed world is joy!

5

## Jesus v. Satan

Jesus clashes with Satan several times in the wilderness, and when Satan possesses people - and (spoiler alert!) Jesus always wins.

6

## Listen, then serve.

Luke highlights the heart of discipleship: not status, but service. True disciples listen, follow, and rejoice in the spirit.

7

## A new worldview

In Luke's Gospel, the poor will be rich; the humble will be exalted. No sin is unforgivable.

## Canticles

Beautiful songs of praise. Mary's Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55), Zechariah's Benedictus (Luke 1:68-79), the angels' Gloria in Excelsis (Luke 2:14), and Simeon's Nunc Dimittis (Luke 2:29-32)

9

## Extravagant Grace

God's forgiveness is undeserved and complete. It's not about how good you've been, but how open your heart is to return.

10

## The Cost of Love

Like the Good Samaritan, disciples of Jesus invest time, money, and take risks. Mercy isn't theoretical—it requires sacrifice and inconvenience.

## Thoughts from Fr. Tom

**Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things.** We hear these famous words of Jesus in the Gospel story today. Jesus visits the home of **Martha and Mary** and while Martha is busy about the tasks of hospitality, her sister Mary sits at the feet of Jesus and listens to him. As hospitality was seen as a critical virtue to practice in Jesus' culture, Martha would seem to be focused on the right thing. But Jesus says Mary has chosen the better part. It seems to be not so much about the activity each has chosen but the state of mind. As she is busy about her tasks, Martha is frustrated with her sister which causes her to feel burdened. We can all relate to Martha in our lives. While Martha and Mary are often held up as examples of the active and contemplative aspects of faith, there is more to it than that. The goal is to find joy in whatever we are doing by staying focused on Christ. Whether we are busy about the tasks of daily life or sitting quietly in prayer, Jesus is there in our midst. We might ask ourselves: **what worries and anxieties do I need to let go of in order to keep my focus on Christ?**

Wieslaw Bajor CSsR of the **Polish Redemptorists** who will be giving the homily at all the Masses as part of the annual **Missionary Appeal** of our diocese.
