Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. We hear these famous words of Jesus in the Gospel story today. Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary and while Martha is busy about the tasks of hospitality, her sister Mary sits at the feet of Jesus and listens to him. As hospitality was seen as a critical virtue to practice in Jesus' culture, Martha would seem to be focused on the right thing. But Jesus says Mary has chosen the better part. It seems to be not so much about the activity each has chosen but the state of mind. As she is busy about her tasks, Martha is frustrated with her sister which causes her to feel burdened. We can all relate to Martha in our lives. While Martha and Mary are often held up as examples of the active and contemplative aspects of faith, there is more to it than that. The goal is to find joy in whatever we are doing by staying focused on Christ. Whether we are busy about the tasks of daily life or sitting quietly in prayer, Jesus is there in our midst. We might ask ourselves: what worries and anxieties do I need to let go of in order to keep my focus on Christ?

This weekend we welcome to our parish Fr. Wieslaw Bajor CSsR of the **Polish Redemptorists** who will be giving the homily at all the Masses as part of the annual **Missionary Appeal** of our diocese. The Polish Redemptorists are doing important work to bring the faith and needed hope to the people of Ukraine and Russia as well as those in other parts of the world. 


