# Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In response to a plea from one of the disciples to teach them how to pray, Jesus says in the Gospel today: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test. This is Luke's version of the "Our Father". A reminder that God's mercy is abundant and that our daily needs are provided for by the God who loves us. In this version, there seems to be an assumption that because of God's forgiveness of our sins there is a natural response to forgive others. Forgiving others is a continual challenge for most of us and something we should pray for often - to forgive as God forgives. Through Jesus, we are invited into an intimate relationship with God. Jesus continues by reminding us that by being persistent in our prayer and asking, seeking, and knocking, we will receive, find, and be opened. As the saying goes, prayer changes things, and us!

Last fall I shared that the diocese had engaged a consulting firm to conduct a **Planning Study** that included the three parishes in Lee's Summit. The study especially looked at ways our parishes can respond to the projected population growth in Lee's Summit. The need for collaboration among the parishes was particularly highlighted in the final conclusions of the study as well as addressing specific needs in each parish. As you may know, St. Margaret's Parish is currently in the process of a total renovation of their worship space into a permanent church building. This is something that has been desired for awhile and will hopefully be complete by the end of the year. I have had a couple of sneak peeks of the space and it looks beautiful. 



### Ministerio Hispano



#### SEÑOR, ENSÉÑAME A ORAR

Queridos amigos y amigas, las lecturas de este domingo provienen de Génesis 18,20-32; Colosenses 2,12-14. El Evangelio es según San Lucas 11,1-13.

¿Es importante la oración hoy en día? Un estudio espiritual sobre la oración, realizado en 2023-2024 por el "Pew Re-

search Centre", (Centro de Investigación de Iglesias) indicó que el 44 % de los adultos en Estados Unidos oran una vez al día, mientras que el 87 % de quienes oraron reportaron haber recibido una respuesta a su oración en el último año. El mismo estudio reveló que el 61 % de estas personas oraba en sus autos, el 55 % oraba antes de acostarse y el 46 % en lugares de culto. Lo más importante aquí es que la gente ora. ¿Tú también oras?

En tiempos de Jesús, sus discípulos se acercaron para pedirle que les enseñara a orar. Esto significa que lo observaron orando. Se inspiraron en su práctica. Se sintieron atraídos a seguir la vida de Jesús, el Maestro.

Cuando Jesús enseña sobre la oración, lo hace de forma muy fácil. Pidan y se les dará, busquen y encontrarán, toquen y se les abrirá. Suena bastante simple, porque Jesús tiene una profunda relación con Dios su Padre. Con esta enseñanza, Jesús invita a sus discípulos a desarrollar esta relación de niño con Dios, depositando toda su confianza en Él.

Sin embargo, ¿qué pasa con aquellas personas cuyas oraciones parecen no ser respondidas y viven sumidas en una ola de decepciones? Jesús las insta a persistir en pedir, buscar y tocar, porque Dios actúa con amor, compasión y su generosidad es infinita.

En verdad, hay momentos en que la vida te golpea fuerte y no sabes qué hacer ni cómo orar a Dios. Como Abraham y los discípulos, solo necesitas acercarte a Dios y pedirle con insistencia: Señor, enséñame a orar o enséñame a manejar esta situación. El Espíritu de Dios vendrá en tu ayuda: "El Espíritu intercede por nosotros con gemidos indecibles" (Romanos 8:26).

Unámonos, pues, a nuestro Dios en oración. Dedicar por lo menos treinta o una hora diaria o semanalmente a sentarnos y conversar con Dios. Si lo hacemos con confianza y perseverancia, mejorará nuestra relación con Dios y cambiará nuestra vida para siempre. Les agradezco de corazón por la fiesta de bienvenido de domingo pasado. ¡Somos amigos por siempre en Cristo y la Santísima Virgen Maria!
