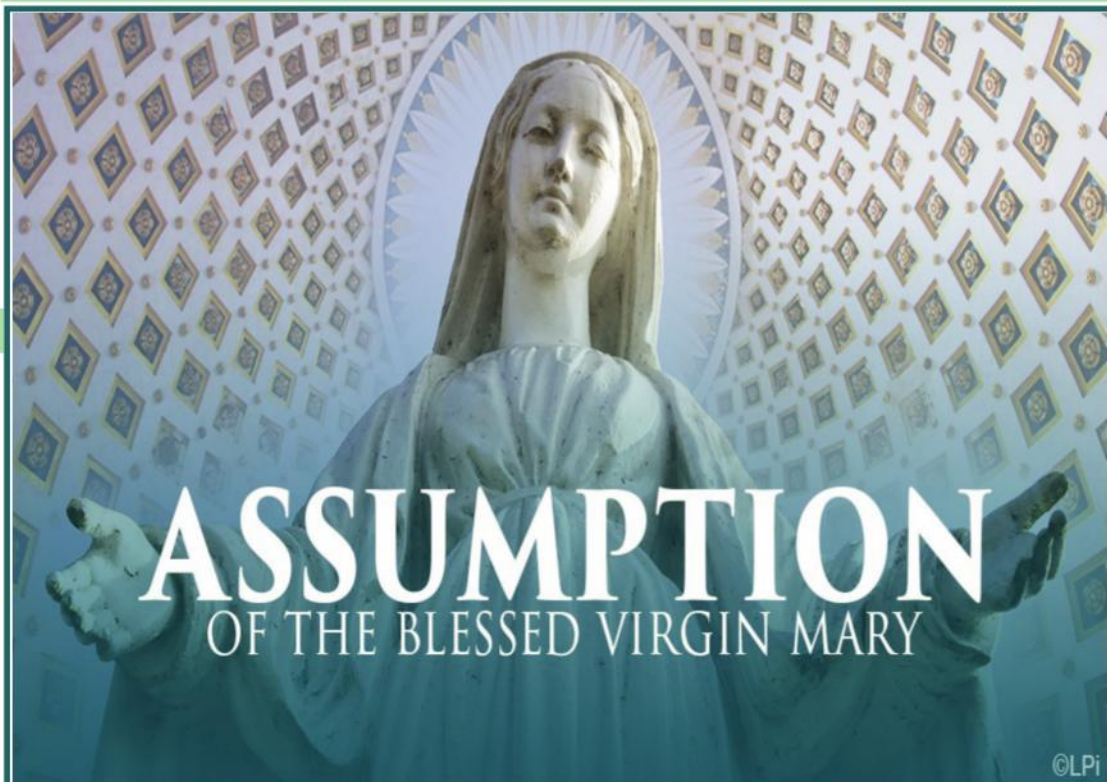

Sign up and name the child you are adopting.

Individuals, couples, and families are welcome to sign up after Masses August 16-17. You are asked to pray for this unborn child and his/her parents for nine months, beginning September 8, the birthday of the Virgin Mary.

Every month, in our bulletin,

we will publish information about the growth of the unborn child and suggest prayers and actions.

Which prayers do I use?

You can use whatever prayers you like or use one from the Holy Family and/or Our Lady of Guadalupe (patroness of the unborn) prayer cards that are available when you sign up.

You may want to offer a rosary once a month, perform service in the child's name, or light a votive candle.

How much does this cost?

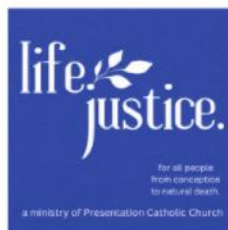
The only cost is the time you spend in prayer. We will offer opportunities to make donations to mothers in need periodically, but these are not required. Perhaps you will spend some of your prayer time making a baby blanket or layette items.

How does a Spiritual Adoption help?

Your prayers for parents encourage them to respond to God's grace as they welcome a child into life.

Monthly updates educate adults and children about the development of an unborn child.





Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel this week continues the theme from last week as we are once again invited to reflect on the treasure of our faith. Jesus says, **where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.** As we hear this Gospel, is our heart in the right place? Maybe we need to readjust what we treasure in life. If our focus is on our belongings and earthly possessions, we may find ourselves like the servant in the parable who is not prepared and ready for the coming of the master. But Jesus calls us to be servants that are vigilant and blessed because our hearts are in the right place. He reminds us that we are the ones who have been **entrusted with more** because of the faith that has been shared with us. May our lives reflect the treasure we have been given and may we always be the servants who are ready and prepared.

The **Knights of Columbus Ladies Auxiliary** from our parish are again this year sponsoring the **Baby Bottle Campaign**. This is an opportunity for us to support the gift of life and help provide resources for the Meet Life Campaign that assists Missouri and local charities that protect the unborn. Please plan to join us in the Mulligan Room for refreshments and fellowship. There will also be plenty of opportunities to sign-up as a volunteer in several of our parish ministries. We are grateful for all the volunteers who help us continue the many ministries and good work of our parish.

This Friday, August 15, is the **Feast of the Assumption of Mary**. The Vigil Mass for the holy day will be on **Thursday, August 14, at 6:00 p.m.** The other holy day Masses will be at **6:30 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. on Friday, August 15**. 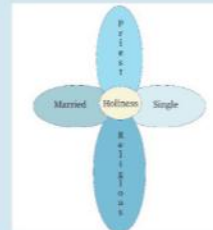
