Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Today we celebrate the **Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross**. When this feast falls on a Sunday it takes the place of the Sunday in Ordinary Time. The origin of this feast is linked to the discovery of the true Cross attributed to St. Helena on September 14, 320. Helena was the mother of Emperor Constantine, who legalized Christianity in the Roman empire. Over time, it became customary on this day for churches to "lift up" their crosses in a ceremony called the Exaltation. The Cross stands as a reminder of the depth of God's love for us. As we hear in the Gospel, **For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life**. The Cross is our hope that good wins out over evil, that life wins out over death, and that sin and death have been conquered forever. May we lift high the Cross in our lives and follow the life it symbolizes.

This week our Wednesday **Children's Faith Formation (CFF)** program officially begins and activities for our Middle School and High School Youth Ministry programs begin for the year. We also have a number of 2nd graders who will begin their preparation for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist and a number of 6th graders who will begin their preparation for Confirmation. Please be sure any children or youth in your life are participating in these offerings. We are blessed by their presence.

Next weekend we are having a **second collection** for our sister community in **San Rafael Cedros, El Salvador**. Your financial contributions will support the youth of the community through scholarships to high school and college. This is an important outreach ministry of our parish and a way we unite with our brothers and sisters in El Salvador. We support the scholarship students throughout the year, so your generosity with the second collection will help with this effort. Please use the envelope provided in your monthly contribution packet, use your own envelope designated for El Salvador, or contribute through Online Giving on our website. You may have read about the violence and government suppression happening in El Salvador, so our efforts to educate young people in the country is all important. Thanks for your continued support of this ministry.

Next weekend is a **Celebrating Stewardship** weekend and **Nametag Sunday**! Come a little early to get your nametag and plan to stay after Mass to learn about some of our ministries and enjoy some refreshments and fellowship with other parishioners. These are great ways to build community, so take time to join us.

Next weekend we also celebrate **Catechetical Sunday**. We give thanks for all those in our parish community who use their gifts to pass on the faith to others. This includes teachers in our various education programs, volunteers in our many ministries, coaches, and especially parents. 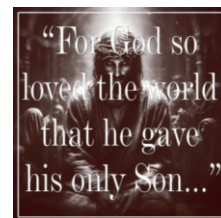

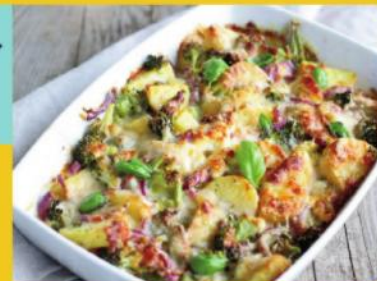

Ministerio Hispano



El Poder Transformador de la Cruz

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, este domingo celebramos la Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz. Nuestras lecturas provienen de Números 21,4-9; Filipenses 2,6-11 y el Evangelio según San Juan 3,13-17. Esta fiesta conmemora dos acontecimientos. En primer lugar, el descubrimiento de la verdadera cruz en la que Jesús fue crucificado y murió, y en segundo lugar, la recuperación de esta cruz tras la invasión persa, con la ayuda de las cruzadas cristianas.

Normalmente, asociamos la cruz con el sufrimiento, la humillación y la tortura. Cuando alguien dice que lleva una cruz en la vida, entendemos que está sufriendo. Para nosotros, los cristianos, la cruz se ve a través de los ojos de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, quien por medio de la cruz nos salvó y nos concedió la vida eterna. Los Padres de la Iglesia afirmaban: *"Si Jesús no hubiera entregado su vida en la cruz por la salvación del mundo, la cruz nunca habría sido motivo de exaltación."* Hoy, glorifiquemos a Dios por la salvación que nos ha dado mediante la crucifixión de su Hijo.

Nosotros también participamos de la cruz de Cristo cuando sufrimos. A través de la cruz que llevemos,

comprendamos con humildad que Dios puede exaltar cada sufrimiento que atravesemos en la vida y, por medio de él, derramará abundantemente su gracia.

Recuerda cuál ha sido tu mayor prueba, tu mayor sufrimiento, llévalo con fe y esperanza. Entrega todas tus pruebas y carga a Jesús y pedirle a Dios la gracia de la felicidad. Recuerda que, sea cual sea tu mayor carga, tu fe, tu esperanza y tu confianza en Dios pueden transformarla y convertirla en fuente de bendición en tu vida, por el poder transformador de Dios.

Esta semana, reflexiona sobre las dificultades que por las que estés atravesando. Acéptalas y, posteriormente, aparta un momento para presentarlas a Jesús en la adoración del Santísimo Sacramento. Porque Jesús nos dice: *"Porque Dios no envió a su Hijo, Jesús, para condenar al mundo, sino para que el mundo sea salvo por él"* (Juan 3:17).

Que nuestra relación con Dios y con Jesús siga creciendo en todas las circunstancias de la vida. Gracias por nuestra participación en nuestra celebración hispana de ayer. Gracias por los sacrificios que hicieron para que esta actividad fuera posible. Seamos hermanos y amigos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
