Systemic Racism

Today, racism continues to exist in our communities and our parishes. Racism is what causes us to view the "other" with suspicion or attribute negative characteristics to an entire group of people. This evil manifests itself in our thoughts and also in the workings of our society itself. Today's continuing inequalities in education, housing, employment, wealth, and representation in leadership positions are rooted in our country's shameful history of slavery and systemic racism.

- **Unemployment rates for African Americans, Latinos, and Native Americans are considerably higher than the national average, contributing to growing income inequality.**
- **In the United States, median wealth for white households is 10 times greater than for black households and eight times greater for Hispanic households.**
- **African Americans, Latinos and Native Americans are disproportionately affected through every stage of the criminal justice system, despite the evidence that different racial and ethnic groups commit crimes at roughly the same rates.**

Racism can only end if we contend with the policies and institutional barriers that perpetuate and preserve the inequality—economic and social—that we still see all around us. With renewed vigor, we call on members of the Body of Christ to join others in advocating and promoting policies at all levels that will combat racism and its effects in our civic and social institutions.

As Christians, we are constantly called to examine our own hearts and consciences for how we might contribute to or break down racial divisions, intolerance, and discrimination.

Our failure to act to end systemic racism hurts those who are victimized and denies all of us the opportunity to benefit from the gifts of diversity.

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

At first glance in today's Gospel, it seems as if Jesus is praising the efforts of a dishonest steward. But Jesus is not using him as an example because of his dishonesty, but rather for the creativity he uses in dealing with his situation. The Gospel ends with the words: **You cannot serve both God and mammon**, which is a warning to those whose sole focus is to secure gain for themselves. Jesus speaks about the children of this world using the wealth entrusted to them in more prudent ways than the children of light who have been entrusted with eternal wealth. Our focus should not be on the passing things of this world, but on the things that last forever. **Are we creative and prudent and trustworthy in the ways we use our gifts?** As Jesus reminds us, we cannot serve two masters. Through our faith in Jesus, we are invited to always live in the light. May we always know the source of our light and allow it to shine brightly.

This weekend is our **second collection** for our sister community in **El Salvador**. All contributions help us provide scholarships for young people in the community to attend high school and university. Education is a major way for these young people to move out of poverty, find meaningful jobs, and provide for their families. Please support this collection. This weekend is also **Catechetical Sunday**, a time to celebrate all those who give of their time and talent to share the faith with others. We are blessed with many people who help in our various education ministries, faith formation programs, sacrament preparation programs, scripture studies, small groups, and sports programs. We are grateful for your commitment to our parish.

We continue to offer our prayers for the community of Annunciation Parish and School in Minneapolis and healing from the violence that too often surrounds us. In his remarks after the shooting, expressing his heartbreak and prayers for the victims, Archbishop Hebda of Minneapolis also included these words which are good for all of us to reflect on: *We need an end to gun violence. Our community is rightfully outraged at such horrific acts of violence perpetrated against the vulnerable and innocent. They are far too commonplace.*



Queridos hermanos y hermanas, las lecturas de este domingo provienen del Profeta Amós 8:4-7; 1 Timoteo 2:1-8 y el evangelio según San Lucas 16:1-13. Las lecturas nos enseñan a ser administradores responsables, honestos tanto en lo pequeño como en lo grande.

Corresponsabilidad es vivir con la profunda consciencia de que todo lo que tenemos pertenece a Dios. El uso fiel de la riqueza para el propósito de Dios, en lugar de la acumulación egoísta, es la clave para la seguridad eterna.

Simplemente pasa, y en ese sentido, no es nuestro y es algo pasajero, solo lo obtenemos para esta vida. ¿Qué podemos poseer y nunca perder? Es Jesucristo, a quien Dios nos ofrece en vida. Al poseer a Jesús, nunca podemos perder nada. Él es nuestra seguridad eterna. Nos concedió el Cielo desde nuestro bautismo; nos convertimos en hijos de la luz desde nuestro bautismo. Así que, decidamos no servir a dos señores, sino dedicar todas nuestras energías a servir a Jesucristo (Lucas 16:13).

Les agradezco a todos por hacer de nuestra Fiesta Hispana un éxito. Les agradezco de corazón por sus sacrificios de tiempo, talentos y tesoros. Gracias a todos nuestros amigos que nos acompañaron en la celebración de este día, recordando nuestras queridas raíces. Seamos amigos y hermanos para siempre en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
