Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In the Gospel this weekend, the apostles say to Jesus: **Increase our faith.** How many times have we thought to ourselves that if only we had more faith our problems would be lessened and our burdens would be lighter? But Jesus' response to the apostles reminds us of one of the important mysteries of our faith: even faith the size of a mustard seed, one of the smallest of seeds, can cause great things to happen. The lesson we learn is that it is not always a matter of having more faith, but using the faith we have already been given. It's the age-old theme of quality being more important than quantity. Our faith is ultimately about our relationship with the person of Christ and finding ways to deepen that relationship. We are called to trust in the gift of faith and live as humble servants who share the abundance of our faith in Christ with others.

We will pray the **Rosary** before each weekend Mass during October asking for Mary's intercession. The Rosary will begin about 25 minutes before Mass, so please come a little early to join in the prayer. We will also have our **outdoor Fatima Rosary** on Saturday, October 11, at 11am in the Mary Garden on the north side of church. In praying the Rosary, we unite with our Blessed Mother in contemplating the mysteries of Christ's life and our call to be faithful disciples.

In this Respect Life month, there are a couple of ways you can support life issues and also help our parish grade school. Parents and students from our school will be selling **FIREBall raffle tickets** after the Masses this weekend. FIRE benefits Catholic schools in our diocese so that children with special needs can attend our schools. Presentation is a FIRE partner school and receives some grant money for our TEAM Lab. Please buy a Raffle ticket. Next weekend you can contribute to the Knights of Columbus **Tootsie Roll Drive** after all the Masses. This annual drive supports children with mental and physical challenges. The Knights generously give all the funds collected after Masses to our school TEAM Lab. Please be generous next weekend.

On **Thursday, October 16**, at 6:30 p.m. in the church we will have a **Parish Evening of Reflection** focused on our parish-wide **Simply Serve** theme. We will reflect on ways we can incorporate the spirit of service into our everyday lives and put our faith into action in meaningful ways. Our parish staff will be leading the retreat and we encourage everyone to attend. Please take time to join us as we grow in our faith together.

Thank you for all the cards, gifts, and words of thanks for Priesthood Sunday last weekend. I am blessed to be a priest in this community. Please continue to pray for vocations and keep the priests of our diocese in prayer as we will be on retreat with our Bishop for a few days this week.

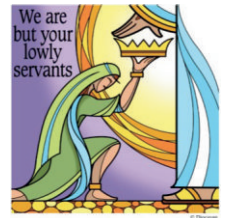

AUMENTA NUESTRA FE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, las lecturas de este Domingo provienen del profeta Habacuc 1:2-3; 2:2-4; 2 Timoteo 1:6-8, 13-14 y el evangelio según san Lucas 17:5-10.

En estas lecturas, el mensaje central es la Fe es un don de Dios. Una fe vibrante nos hace fuertes, amorosos y sabios. Debemos depositar toda nuestra confianza en Dios, quien nos protege de todo mal, porque Dios es la roca de nuestra salvación.

Nos encontramos con Jesús dirigiéndose a sus apóstoles y discípulos sobre las leyes para ser sus verdaderos seguidores. Jesús les dijo que es malo y condenado enseñar a otros a pecar. Les enseñó que el perdón es una necesidad para todos sus discípulos y la fe es la fuerza más grande del mundo.

Esta enseñanza de Jesús conmovió la vida de los apóstoles, quienes suplicaron: **“Señor, aumenta nuestra fe”**. Reacción de los apóstoles nos recuerda que nunca es fácil perdonar. Ese perdón nos agobia a algunos en la vida. Los discípulos sentían, como nosotros, que perdonar es difícil. Esto expresa nuestra naturaleza humana, viviendo sin Dios.

Jesús les confirma a sus apóstoles y discípulos que incluso si tuvieran una pequeña cantidad de fe, como la semilla de un grano de mostaza, se puede lograr hasta lo imposible. En otras palabras, Jesús le dice a sus discípulos que pongan toda su confianza en Dios, si deseas lograr lo que te propongas en la vida.


No busquemos, pues, una fe vacía que pueda derretir montañas, sino que le pidamos a Dios que nos conceda una fe pequeña y genuina, suficiente para que prestemos un gran servicio para su gloria.

Considérate un siervo de Dios, reconociendo que todos tus esfuerzos son simplemente cumplir con lo que Dios te ha llamado a hacer. Durante la semana, intenta practicar nuestro lema parroquial de este año: Simplemente Servir; haz pequeñas cosas con amor, porque todo lo que haces por Dios es solo una pequeña recompensa por la obra de Dios en tu vida. Que tú y yo aceptemos el llamado de Dios con una fidelidad de por vida.

Seamos amigos y hermanos eternos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
