Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Today's Gospel tells the story of the ten lepers being cleansed by Jesus. The lepers were considered outcasts and had to live separate from others. They trusted in the healing Jesus could bring and they followed his instructions to **go show yourselves to the priests** so they could once again belong. But the story goes further when one of the lepers, a Samaritan, returns to thank Jesus. He was an outcast as both a leper and a foreigner. Yet, Jesus singles him out for his gratitude and his faith. Once again, Jesus reveals that God's healing and mercy are for people of all nations. We separate ourselves from the community when we choose to sin and turn away from God. But we do not have to remain outcasts if we trust in the healing Jesus brings to our lives. With faith, we can experience the healing that comes through Christ and always have reason to be grateful.

This weekend our parish Knights will be at the doors after each Mass taking contributions for their annual **Tootsie Roll Drive**. Remember that they designate all the money they collect at Masses to go to our grade school Team Lab which makes it possible for students with special needs to attend our Catholic school. We are grateful for their generosity and encourage you to be generous in giving.

Beginning next weekend, we will kick-off our parish **Stewardship Renewal**. This is a great opportunity for all of us to reflect on the gifts God has shared with us and make a commitment of our *time, talent, and treasure* as a way to share our blessings with our parish and community. 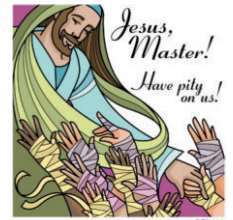

GRACIAS, DIOS MÍO

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, nuestras lecturas de este domingo provienen de 2 Reyes 5:14-17; 2 Timoteo 2:8-13 y el Evangelio según San Lucas 17:11-19. El mensaje fundamental es que la gracia de Dios y su reino están abiertos a todas las personas que responden con fe y gratitud a sus obras diciendo siempre: *Gracias, Dios mío.*

En este domingo, Jesús continúa su viaje a Jerusalén. Lo acompañan sus discípulos. Jerusalén nos recuerda los sufrimientos y la muerte inminentes de Jesús en la cruz. En el camino, Jesús oye el grito de los diez leprosos a lo lejos: "¡Jesús, Maestro! ¡Ten compasión de nosotros!". Al verlos, responde: "Vayan a presentarse a los sacerdotes". Los sacerdotes deben certificar su sanación y su reintegración social.

En el camino al encuentro con los sacerdotes, reconocen sus cambios físicos. Su piel está sana. Se dan cuenta de que están libres de lepra. De los diez, solo un leproso, un samaritano, un extranjero, regresa a Jesús, la fuente de la sanación, el hombre con el poder de sanar. Se postra a sus pies alabando, glorificando y agradeciendo a Dios por la nueva vida recibida.

La historia de estos leprosos nos representa a todos. Somos personas que clamamos a Dios cuando estamos necesitados. Clamamos a Dios para que tenga misericordia de nosotros. Para que nos abra y de nuevas oportunidades. Afortunadamente, cuando Dios concede nuestras peticiones, olvidamos primero dar las gracias, Dios mío. Olvidamos la fuente de nuestras bendiciones: Dios. Nos ocupamos tanto con la obra que Dios te concedió en el momento de tu clamor, y por ese clamor que el Señor nos ofrece, ni siquiera encontramos cinco minutos para glorificarlo.

Esta es una historia de conversión. Jesús enseña que la verdadera conversión es permanecer firme en la fe en Él. Y con un celo ardiente, amar y seguir a Dios, quien te toca y te restaura en tu camino de vida.

Durante la semana, reflexionemos sobre las maneras en que Dios ha tocado nuestras vidas a lo largo del camino en el crecimiento de la fe. ¿Cuál ha sido tu respuesta a la bondad de Dios? Por favor, reza el Salmo 116. Considera apoyar la misión de la iglesia el próximo domingo, "Día Mundial de las Misiones", con una generosa contribución.
